BCMGA

This is the second commandment of golf.

2. Speed of play. Always play without delay at all times. Paramount in this category is to be at your ball, ready to hit, when it is your turn. After the tee shot, all the way to holing out, the order of play is always farthest from the hole first, and there really are no exceptions. Always carry two uniquely-marked balls. Limit your divot-less practice swings to just a few seconds, and never practice swing towards anyone. On the green, study your shot alternatives, line of putt, and putting strategy while others are preparing to hit. You should always hit well within 45 seconds of the previous golfer's stroke. The only way to judge your speed is your position relative to the group in front of you. You are in position if, as you approach your next shot, they are just moving off. Don't lag behind or crowd unnecessarily the group in front. Never talk or tell stories that in anyway, even for a few seconds, delay play. There is plenty of time between shots while walking or riding to the next shot for discourse and jocularity. Consider the score card after hitting, while proceeding to the next shot, never on the tee or green.

In August, we will be having a field day. The sign-up sheet will be in the billiards room (partners or individual). If you don't have a partner, the BCMGA will attempt to make a team for you. This will be an assigned team, first come first served. It is always better to have a friend to play with, but we can assist you in making a team. One of the games that BCMGA is playing this month is the quota point game.

This is an individual quota points game that will be played based on the golfer's handicap. Quota points are based on each golfer's gross score. The quota required is computed using 36 minus the player's handicap for a required quota. If the player has a handicap of 20, then the required quota would be 16. Scoring is as follows: Eagle=6pts, Birdie=4pts, Par=2pts, Bogie=1pt, Double Bogie=0pts, Triple Bogie=-1pt. Individual scores will be posted to GHIN so golfers should play their ball until holed or they reach their handicap equitable score control limit (i.e. net double bogey is the limit). 2024 Florida Disaster Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday:

If you missed the first Sales Tax Holiday in June, there is still time to stock up

on batteries, tarps and more during this second tax holiday. Frequently Asked Questions for Consumers:

If I purchase a gift card during the sales tax holiday, can I then purchase a qualifying item tax exempt using the gift card after the tax holiday ends? No. Purchase of qualifying item must be made during the holiday. If a store issues me a rain check during the sales tax holiday, can I use it after the tax holiday to purchase the item tax-exempt? No. The purchase of the qualifying item The Cypress Lakes Chapter of AMBUCS is up and must be made during the sales tax holiday.

\Does the Disaster Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday also mail order, catalog, or online are exempt when the order is accepted by the company during the sales tax holiday for immediate shipment, even if delivery is made after the Lakes HOA to manage the ramp building activities in tax holiday.

"BETWEEN THE LANES"

The mission of Courtesy Patrol is to provide a secure, quick and pleasant entry experience into Cypress Lakes Village for our residents, guests, visitors and contractors, with accuracy and accountability and an emphasis on safety with our Rover Patrol.

This month we would like to ask, "Do you know the difference between Traffic Law and Driving Etiquette?"

Traffic Law covers many driving-related offenses such as speeding, running a stop sign or a red light which typically involves a fine and points being assessed to your driving record. Driving Etiquette is a tolerant behavior while driving also known as good manners, chosen over rudeness, setting a good example to our guests, contractors and delivery drivers coming from outside the community.

Our Cypress Lakes Village community is a melting pot of friends, neighbors, co-workers, team players, committee members, social clubs...another words, "a village - a self-contained community within a city with features characteristic of village life." Important to this concept is the value of taking time to treat each other with patience, kindness, tolerance, and the utmost respect. Check your frame of mind and attitude as you venture out. Here are a few tips for practicing good manners between the lanes – important to changing rudeness that compromises safety...which always comes first!

<u>Clubhouse</u>, <u>Administration Building</u>, and the <u>Grill</u>: Give pedestrians, vehicles and golf carts the right of way at the Grill. Be kind and prepared to stop. Be patient and wait...don't speed around pedestrians and cars in the process of backing out and don't honk the horn...it is startling.

<u>Parking:</u> Be courteous and observe the signs and park in the Disability Spots only if you have a Disability Placard. <u>Tailgating:</u> This is considered rude and aggressive! We need to be kind so leave a car length between golf carts and vehicles/motorcycles. Use your key card when exiting the North Gate. DO NOT tailgate the car in front of you...this adds time to the mechanism that opens and closes the gates.

<u>Cypress Lakes Posted Speed Limit is 15 MPH:</u> This is in effect from the moment we turn off Rt. 98, through the Main Gatehouse or the North Gate and as we travel through our village. Move cautiously through the Main Gatehouse and be courteous to vehicles in the Visitor Lane coming to one of your homes. Cutting them off by speeding in front of them is rude.

<u>Stop Signs:</u> One of the most powerful, safe, and courteous practices is to observe all stop signs whether you are in a golf cart or a vehicle/motorcycle. Don't run the stop signs.

<u>Passing:</u> Never pass a golf cart or a vehicle/motorcycle on the inside lane – next to the curb: this is startling to the driver in front of you. Do not pass on our bridges…be kind and tolerant and keep your place in the lane until it becomes safe to pass.

<u>Let's all share social space in our Cypress Lakes Village community, by observing traffic law and practicing driving etiquette - good manners between the lanes.</u>
