Happy Fall. I am sure it is starting to cool down where you are, but it is still summer here in Florida.

September and October Is the prime time for a Hurricane. Please always be prepared. Follow the local weather alerts and/or NOAA warnings and review the suggestions we put in the newsletter to ensure you have a plan. If you need to evacuate. Please do so. We do not have a designated hurricane safe shelter on property. If you decide to stay, make sureyou have plenty of water and food for everyone in your unit including your pet. When a storm approaches, if you need assistance, be sure to connect with a neighbor or call the office. We can help direct you the best way we can by giving you the phone number and address of a local shelter. Shelters are not known until a storm is announced and evacuations are in place. Normally it is a nearby school.

The last storm Helene devastated Florida and States above us. We were very lucky here at River Vista with a few large branches down in the roads and on a few RV sites. We did not receive the home flooding like the rest of the west coast. Our docks and boat slips with the brutal high water and current were again damaged. We have scheduled a professional dock contractor to review the docks to make sure they are rentable for this season.

The clubhouse is open along with the fitness center. We do have one machine out of order that should be fixed before the snowbirds return.

We started the installation of the new freshwater tank. This project will take a while to complete so I do not have a completion date.

Sales – we currently have 4 units for sale. If you are interested in viewing the units, please give the office a call and we can get you in contact with a sales representative.

A MESSAGE FROM THE OFFICE

Speed Limit

The speed limit within the park is 5MPH along the water and 10MPH throughout the park. All vehicles and operators must be properly licensed and insured. All golf cart operators must possess a valid drivers license. Children 16 years or younger on golf cart must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Parking

Two vehicles per site. No overnight parking in the sports court or clubhouse parking lots. Do not park on other resident/guest lots without written permission from the office. Do not park on unoccupied lots.

If you need to park your vehicle or boat for longer than 12 hours in an unauthorized spot, please let the office know so we do not bother you to move it or call a towing service. Please contact the office if you need additional

parking.

Parking on the street is not allowed per 911.

Quite Time is between 10PM and 7:30AM.

<u>Discharge of firearms or fireworks</u> is prohibited. Disorderly conduct, intoxication, profanity or excessive noise will not be tolerated. Any person causing a disturbance will be required to vacate.

<u>River Vista assumes no responsibility</u> for lost or stolen items or for damages due to routine maintenance, or acts of God. River Vista assumes no responsibility for swimmers, skiers, boaters, kayakers or other water related activities.

Garbage & Dumping: Garbage compactor is located in front of the maintenance yard. Only place household garbage in compactor. Dumping of construction materials, paint, electronics, furniture, mattresses, grills, or appliances is a violation and subject to a fine.

Boat Ramp and Fishing Docks: Please be respectful and clean up after use. Turn off water and place trash in cans provided. No parking on the picnic/firepit side of the boat ramp.

Fitness Center: You must be 18 years and over to use the fitness equipment. No exceptions.

<u>Firepits:</u> Small firepits located in boat ramp area are for personal use weather permitting. Use caution when lighting and be sure the fire is completely out prior to leaving the area. No firepits or open fires allowed on sites.

Guests: Any daytime or overnight guests are required to be registered to the main office. Homeowner/Tenant must accompany guests when using building facilities, including gym, pool, sports courts etc.

Pool: Pool hours are 8am-dusk.

No Lifeguard, Swim at your own risk. Children
16 years or younger must be accompanied
by a parent or responsible adult to amenities and
all recreational areas. Please be sure to RINSE
before entering pool and spa. For safety, Pool
will be closed during severe weather conditions,
including heavy rainfall, strong wind gusts and
lightning.

Pets: Maximum of 2 registered pets per site. All pet must be walked on a leash. Be respectful, do not walk your pet on others sites. You must clean up after your pet, and dispose of waste properly. Poop stations are located in several areas of the park. No tying or chaining or unattended pets outside. No pets are allowed in amenity areas including sports courts, clubhouse, welcome center, mail center, laundry and bathhouse.



RESIDENT HURRICANE READINESS GUIDE

Living in a recreational vehicle, park model or manufactured home is a great lifestyle, but when storms head our way, RV's, 5th wheels, travel trailers, park models and manufactured homes should not be considered a place of shelter. Our clubhouse is not rated as a shelter either – so in these few pages we will try and provide some information for you regarding how to get ready for stormy weather when an evacuation is ordered. We are fortunate to live in a county where there is plenty of helpful information and lots of shelters including pet friendly ones. We hope we don't have to "buckle up for a bumpy ride" this year, but it certainly never hurts to be prepared.

Remember, you can always evacuate before an evacuation order is given. Doing so will help ensure you arrive at your storm-safe location without delay. Make sure your Community Manager has your current email and phone information so they can provide community updates.

DURING THE HURRICANE WATCH

- 1. Plug-in/charge all battery-operated devices.
- 2. Turn refrigerator and freezer to coldest settings. Open only when necessary.
- 3. Withdraw cash for one week of expenses.
- 4. Place valuables in a safety deposit box.
- 5. Restock emergency kit with flashlight, batteries, cash and first aid supplies.
- 6. Fill your car's gas tank and refill propane tanks.
- 7. Stock up on drinking water.
- 8. Refill prescription drugs and obtain special medications.
- 9. Outline emergency plans with your family.
- 10. Arrange for the safety of your pets. Ensure your pets have current vaccinations and you have their paperwork.
- 11. Gather things you will need if you go to a shelter. Ensure your hurricane survival kit is packed and ready to go at a moment's notice.
- 12. Stay tuned to radio and TV stations for weather reports.

DURING THE HURRICANE WARNING

- 1 Protect windows by lowering awnings or installing window protection.
- 2 Bring in outdoor furniture and clear yard of loose objects.
- 3 Lower your television antenna, be careful not to touch power lines.
- 4 Plan to evacuate, if ordered.

EVACUATION

If an evacuation order is issued for our area, make sure your home is secure and then leave immediately. All residents of Manufactured Home and RV Communities are required by law to leave if an evacuation order has been given for the area.

- 1. Turn off water, gas, and electricity.
- 2. Unplug and secure high-value electronics equipment.
- 3. Take important papers with you, including insurance papers and identification with your local address.
- 4. Store water in bathtubs, barrels, jugs, and other containers. Use this water for bathing and sanitary purpose. (Not suitable for drinking).
- 5. Let relatives and the community office know where you are going.
- 6. Evacuate to a designated shelter!

RECOMMENDED ITEMS FOR A HURRICANE KIT FOR A SHELTER

- 1. Medication for 30 days / personal first aid kit
- 2. Bedding material (sleeping bag) and pillow / lounge chair / extra clothes
- 3. Personal hygiene items / eye mask for sleeping / towel & wash cloth
- 4. Personal phone book (email addresses)
- 5. Bottled water (1 gallon per person per day)
- 6. Non-perishable food and snacks for 1 week
- 7. Manual can opener / utility knife / plastic eating utensils
- 8. Battery operated radio with headset (extra batteries)
- 9. Flashlights (1 per person) / butane lighter
- 10. Playing cards / magazines & books / puzzles
- 11. Copies of important documents (deeds, titles, wills, insurance policies, medical records, passport, birth certificate, billing statements for credits cards and loans)




