


My dad's kidney journey began in 2012. He applied for term life insurance and was denied due to the results of blood work showing he was in Stage 1 kidney failure. For a few years after he tried alternative treatments that helped control additional kidney failure. In 2020 he received tough news that his GFR was a 23, reflecting Stage 5 kidney failure. He continued to work, albeit shorter days, but in 2022 his exhaustion took over, loss of appetite and shortness of breath finally led him to the ER. After a GFR of 5, 2 units of iron and a blood transfusion, he was given a dialysis port in his chest and thus began the dialysis treatment. He would stay on dialysis for the next 2.5 years while waiting patiently on the kidney donor list.

During those 2.5 years, most days were fina, but so many came with extreme nausea, more exhaustion, and frustration. March of 2024, I made the decision to see if I was a match. Sure enough, I was and 6 months later, September 9th, my dad was able to use my kidney. As of today, my dad has a new outlook on life and is stronger than before. We are blessed to have had the support of our family and friends through this process. Reflecting on all the messages, phone calls, car rides for Fiona and Reid, meal trains, well wishes and prayers during this entire process, remind us of how incredibly blessed we are!

## 10 Traditional Hanukkah Foods to Celebrate the Festival of Lights

Whether you're throwing a big <u>Hanukkah party</u> or hosting a smaller intimate dinner complete with a <u>Hanukkah movie</u>, celebrate in the most delicious way possible with these traditional Hanukkah foods — plus a few new twists (skillet carrot latkes, anyone?).

Observed starting at sundown on December 25th this year, the **Festival of Lights** marks the rededication of Jerusalem's Holy Temple during the second century B.C.E. As the story goes, the Maccabees revolted against Greek occupiers and recaptured the temple. The eight-night celebration honors the fight of the Maccabees for religious freedom and Jewish independence in 142 B.C.E. Victorious, this group of warriors moved to rededicate their holy temple but had only a small amount of oil to light the menorah. Miraculously, the flame burned for eight full days.

Today, many of the customs, <u>Hanukkah decorations</u> and foods served honor the miracle of oil, such as the lighting of a menorah each night of the celebration. Hanukkah recipes often use oil to commemorate that same oil that kept the lights burning — which means many of the foods on this list are cooked in oil — and lots of it! 'Tis the season for crispy fried latkes and deep-fried pillowy sufganiyot. That said, there are plenty of hearty mains, fun appetizers and fresh sides to round out your Hanukkah menu.

So go ahead and make the most of the holiday with an abundance of delicious foods. Happy Hanukkah!

Then you would obtain an event form, complete it, and return it to me, Bea Koch, Lifestyle Coordinator. You are also welcome to attend a monthly planning meeting where we discuss upcoming events. No one controls the event and activities calendar. Ideas are shared, a consensus reached, and many successful events and activities have been the product of such meetings. A win-win! The May calendar had many new, original events thanks to residents coming forward, making the suggestion, then taking the lead in the planning.

Presently, we have 41 ambassadors, who not only plan events and activities, but also volunteer to set up, shop, and clean up from activities. That's teamwork!

If you would like to host a private gathering, there is a form for you to complete. This form can be completed and submitted for approval. Why the paperwork when in the past, residents simply gathered on their own, without the intervention of 'the landlord'? When our park consisted of 30 homes, things could be more casual. Now with 129 households, and so many improvements going on within our park, it is important for both entities to know what is going on in the way of gatherings. EX....
