



Come on down to the clubhouse and play with us!! We play every **2nd & 4th Tuesday**, **12:30-2:30 pm**.


Fast Track is a board game and is similar to Sorry/Aggravation. Beginners welcome – we'll teach you how to play. There's always a lot of talking and laughing!!




