We currently have 2 units for sale. They are both one bedroom/one bath. If you are planning to sell your unit, you must let the office know before putting a sign in your window.

The boat ramp and firepits are open. Please remember to clean up after each use which includes putting out the campfire and cleaning up the ring. Please only use natural wood in the firepits. No treated wood or pallets. Please if you are using the fishing pier down at the boat launch, do not leave your vehicle or golf cart parked on the concrete. Use the grass on the east side of the boat launch. For those of you who have a concrete driveway or carport, please use that for parking and do not park on the grass.

BIG REMINDER – PLEASE do not put anything down your toilet other than toilet paper. Our sewer system cannot handle wipes, flushable or not.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET! THERE ARE PLENTY OF DOGGIE DEPOT AREAS AROUND THE PARK. This is not only a park rule it is also a Hillsborough county rule! All pets MUST be on a leash, no longer than 6ft, when outside your home or RV. No unattended tying/caging and NO electric fences.

Speed limit inside the community is 10mph.

Quite time is between 10pm and 7:30 am Pool – swim at your own risk (NO LIFEGUARD), pool closed at dusk, NO night swimming and NO glass, No food and No Pets in the pool area, amenities/sports courts. No smoking or the use of electronic cigarettes in the Clubhouse or in any other amenity buildings. Please while traveling the streets at night, wear a flashlight while walking or biking and all golf carts MUST keep their lights on.

If you hear rumors – come to the office and ask. Do not assume you are receiving the correct information.

The History of Gasparilla


The name and foundation of Tampa's traditional Ye Mystic Krewe of Gasparilla Pirate Invasion and Parade come from legendary pirate Jose Gaspar, "last of the Buccaneers," who terrorized the coastal waters of West Florida during the late 18th and early 19th century.

As an aristocrat by birth and officer in the Spanish Navy, Gaspar was well educated, possessed courtly manners and had all the appearances of a fine gentleman.

When Jose Gaspar died, he supposedly left an untold fortune in buried treasure somewhere along the Florida coast. Though that treasure has never been discovered, the story of the swashbuckling Gaspar was unearthed and his memory revived in 1904 when Ye Mystic Krewe of Gasparilla was formed and adopted the pirate as patron rogue of their city-wide celebration.
