Please ensure that your account is paid up to date as it will incur additional fees. Late fee notices are sent out on the 12th of each month. If you are unsure of what your monthly amount is, please do not hesitate to contact the office. If you are having hardships, please contact the office to discuss your account. Failure to pay the monthly amount required, can result in eviction.

The Irish American connection is a deep and historical relationship originating mainly on large-scale Irish immigration to the United States due to the famine in the mid-19th century. Over the years since then, Irish immigrants have played a major role in American life contributing in many ways to the building of this great nation. Notably, three Irish-born individuals signed the Declaration of Independence, highlighting their presence in early American history. More than any other nation, the United States has provided unstinting friendship and support throughout Ireland's existence as a free and democratic state. The relationship between our two countries is based not just on common ancestral ties but, crucially, on shared human values.

One demonstration of this is a remarkable gesture of kindness back in 1847 that forged a unique bond between the Irish people and the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma. At that time, Ireland was in the grip of starvation. A bout of blight, a disease that destroys potato plants ruined crops across Europe, having an exceptionally devastating effect on Ireland's rural poor who were essentially enslaved by British landlords. Ironically, these impoverished peasants, who lacked money for food, were put to work exporting grain and other crops to Britain while they themselves were starving. Somehow, word of this preventable tragedy reached the Native American Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, who raised \$170 – the equivalent of \$6,500 today – and sent it to Ireland to aid a starving people, thousands of miles away.

This is even more remarkable because at that time the Choctaws were rebuilding their lives in Indian Territory, modern-day Oklahoma, after being forced to journey hundreds of miles from their homeland in Mississippi. In 1830, President Andrew Jackson had signed the Indian Removal Act, ordering thousands of Native Americans, including Choctaw, Cherokee, Seminole, Chickasaw and Creek Nations, to move to Indian Territory. Thousands of people died from starvation, cold and disease as they made their way to designated reservations in parts of south-east Oklahoma during the march known as the Trail of Tears.

The Irish have never forgotten this act of solidarity and generosity, and to honor the shared history, they built a sculpture which sits today in the small town of Midleton, County Cork. Named Kindred Spirits, the 20 foot sculpture features nine feathers curving up from a concrete foundation, symbolizing the shape of an empty bowl. The delicate feathers which give off a metallic luster when illuminated by the sun, represent the Choctaw Nation's courage, strength, kindness and humanity. In addition to the monument, there are many other examples of the continued link between the Irish and Choctaw people because of that remarkable donation. In 1990, several Choctaw leaders took part in the first annual Famine Walk at Doolough in County Mayo. Two years later, Irish commemoration leaders walked the 500 mile length of the Trail of Tears and former Irish President, Mary Robinson was honored as a Choctaw Chief. Most importantly, both Choctaw and Irish people now work together to provide assistance to those suffering from famine worldwide.

In 2018, Irish Taoiseach (Prime Minister) Leo Varadkar announced a scholarship for Choctaw people to study in Ireland. "This is an opportunity for us to learn from you and from your culture, and you from ours, in a sharing of knowledge that will enrich both our peoples," he said. In 2020, during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Irish people donated over two million dollars in aid to Native Americans severely affected by the crisis.

In 2024 Choctaw leaders unveiled a sculpture in Oklahoma dedicated to their people's connection with Ireland. The Eternal Hearts sculpture was created by Samuel Stitt and was a joint commission, funded by the Irish government and the Chahta Foundation. The sculpture combines a Celtic Trinity Knot intertwined with a heart and is strategically placed facing in the direction of Ireland. Choctaw Nation chief Gary Batton described the sculpture as symbolic of an "eternal bond" and that they are "extremely proud to call the people of Ireland our friends and kindred spirits". The Choctaws are the third largest Native American tribe in the United States, with almost 230,000 members, most of who live in Oklahoma. The people of Ireland cherish the relationship which began with a single act of solidarity and extraordinary generosity during the darkest years of its history.

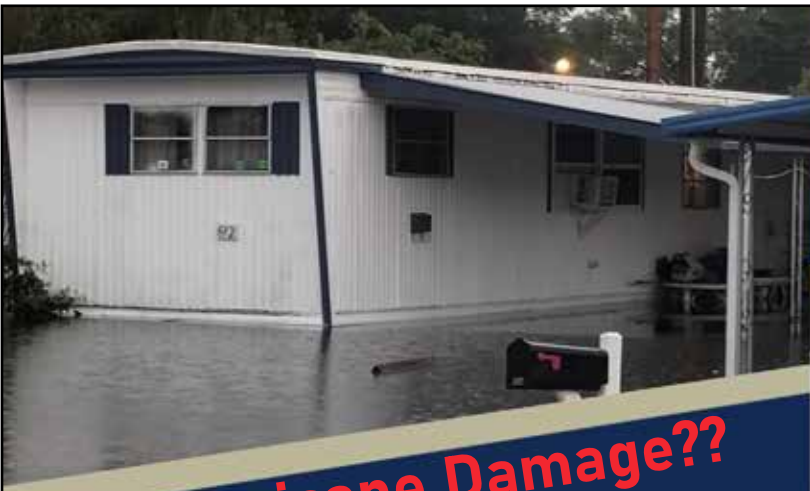

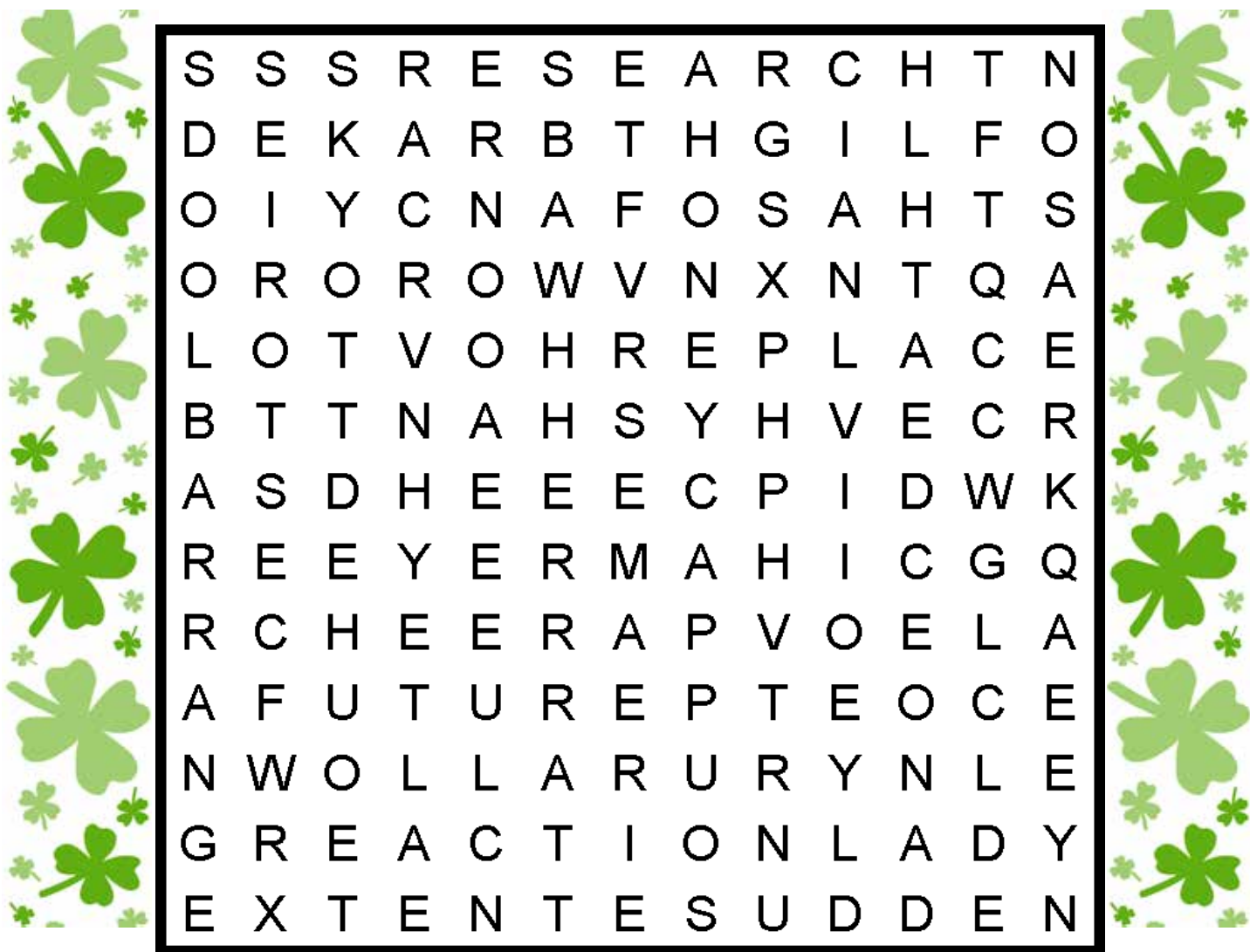
