Manager's Corner - Jeff Belle



Hello Camelot East Residents,



"May is the month of expectation, the month of wishes, the month of hope." I decided to start the Month of May with a quote from Emily Brontë who is known for her novel Wuthering Heights. May is here and we are prepping for some exciting expected projects in the community! First and foremost, the clubhouse is finally underway with our remodel, and we look forward to the changes we have in store for you and the building!

The estimated time for completion is 6 months, dependent on inclement weather or minor issues we may encounter along the way. As discussed in the manager's meeting held on April 15, 2025:

- The clubhouse remodel is scheduled to begin on May 5, 2025.
- All items have been removed from the areas affected and will remain in storage until the work has been completed.
- The current lounge area will now house our Lifestyle Director and Office Assistant (cubicles are being setup).
- The current location of the coffee machine will remain for now, until we can assess if this will become an
 issue with the work that is being conducted. If we do move the machine, we will notify you of its'
 temporary location until the work is completed or until it is suitable to be placed back.
- Please be mindful of the offices that are now located in the lobby. Please do not enter the cubicles, when
 office staff is not present.
- Any activities that were scheduled; (cards, ...etc.) will be played in the ballroom until all work is completed.
- These activities have second priority for any prior scheduled activity, whether HOA or Mgmt. activity or resident function where the ballroom is required/reserved.
- Timeframe for completion is six months.
- Fitness center will still be available for use, however, please enter from the side near the main bathrooms.
- Please do not provide your insight on how the work should be completed. The workers are following the
 engineers' guidelines based off the permit approval for Sarasota County.
- We will begin discussing with the HOA on moving the Veteran's memorial from the clubhouse ballroom to the main lobby. In addition, the U.S. service flags will be standalone and positioned at the rear of the current U.S. and Canadian flags.

As we enter the month of May, let us not forget the great activities and events hosted by our Lifestyle department and HOA alike: Music Bingo - HOA Pool Party - Creative Cooking - Cove & HOA Farewell Wine Down Wednesday - Easter Egg Hunt - Hammered Flower Craft Class - Ambassador Appreciation Day - Women's Chick Flick Night .

These activities were enjoyed by many and appreciated by all. Thank you both for your contributions to continue to keep our residents active and busy! If there is something that you have not seen or would like to see upcoming, please do not hessite to reach out to our lifestyle department! We want to ensure that we continue to provide events and activities that cater to the lifestyle we all come to love in Camelot East. May activities will be sure to delight you! Please ensure that your account is paid up to date as it will incur additional fees. Late fee notices are sent out on the 12th of each month. If you are unsure of what your monthly amount is, please do not hesitate to contact the office. If you are having hardships, please contact the office to discuss your account. Failure to pay the monthly amount required, will result in eviction.

Last, but certainly not least, to our seasonal residents that are returning home, safe travels and we look forward to your return in the fall with a few new surprises in store.


