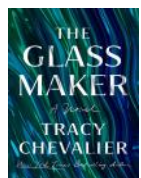
LGHV BOOK CLUB by Donna Kittleman

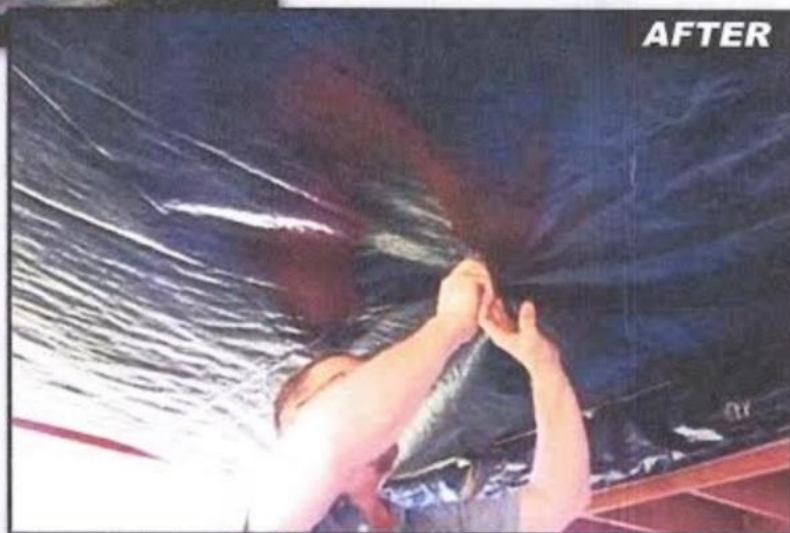

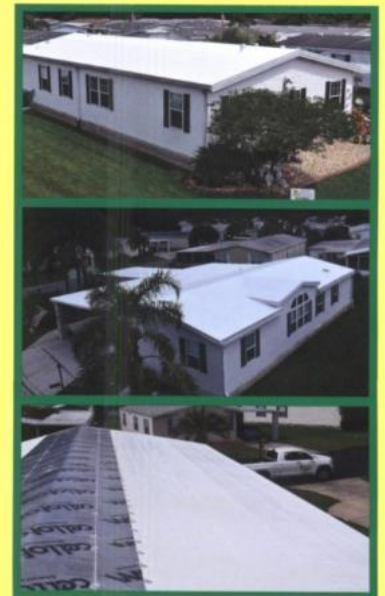
