

Hello, Camelot East residents,

The dog days of summer are upon us, as we continue to make improvements around the community.

Community Project updates:

<u>Asphalt Repair and Sidewalk Replacement:</u> Sidewalk replacement began on July 21, 2025, and was completed at the end of the week. Asphalt road work for Axminster Rd. will begin in the 1st week of August. (Notification to the residents on Axminster will be provided once the date approaches.) Work consists of:

- Complete overlay and milling of Axminster Rd.
- Complete of the remaining portion of sidewalk along Kingsbridge Dr.
- Asphalt repair of depression located at the intersection of Kingsbridge Dr. & Maryport Ln.
- Several small areas within the community for asphalt depression
- Center sewers drain along Kingsbridge Dr. from the sewer grate to the end of the gutter

<u>Ballroom Flooring:</u> Completed on July 22, 2025. (Installation delay due to pre-existing floor that required removal prior to laying the new flooring).

<u>Cabanas and Pool Furniture:</u> Cabanas have been installed, and pool furniture is in transit for delivery (tentative for furniture setup, Mid-August).

<u>Irrigation:</u> Finalized and prepping for scheduling; Finalized pre-construction meeting scheduled for July 23, 2025, and initial work beginning first week in August.

Lake Erosion: Completed.

Solar Blinds (Ballroom): Completed.

<u>Perimeter Fencing (Seven Oaks):</u> Submitted for approval (location will be provided once work is approved).

<u>Clubhouse Upgrades:</u> Currently on track, permitting and inspection completed for new plumbing, concrete work completed, metal studs placed to begin drywall.

- Tennis Court Landscape upgrades
- RV Storage Area Landscaping
- Late Summer / Fall Landscaping

Upcoming Meetings:

- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- ☐ Whistle to signal for help
- ☐ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- ☐ Local maps



Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- ☐ Prescription medications and glasses
- ☐ Infant formula and diapers
- ☐ Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- ☐ Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container
- ☐ Cash and change
- ☐ Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- ☐ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person.
- ☐ Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes.
- ☐ Fire Extinguisher Matches in a waterproof container Feminine supplies, personal hygiene items and hand sanitizer
- ☐ Mess kits, Paper cups, plates and disposable utensils, paper towels














August Trivia

- On August 6, 1762, the first-ever sandwich was created. It was named after the Earl of Sandwich when he requested a dish involving meat between two pieces of bread. As the story goes, he requested it as he was in the middle of a gambling game and didn't want to interrupt it.
- August has also changed its number of days multiple times. In the ten-month Roman calendar,
 the months all had either 30 or 31 days, totaling 304 days in the year. Not only did Pompilius
 add January and February to the calendar, but he also reduced the number of days in August
 down to 29. It wasn't until Julius Caesar introduced the Julian calendar that it was left with 31
 days, and it's stayed the same ever since!
- August is also a little bit unique, most of the time at least. In a standard year, there is no other
 month that begins on the same day of the week as August. In a leap year, however, August
 begins on the same day of the week as February.
- Back in the days of the Anglo-Saxons, the month was called Weod Monath. Its translation of "weed month" is quite literal – in this month weeds and other plants grow the fastest in the northern hemisphere.
- August was a fateful month for the ancient Roman city of Pompeii. On <u>August 24</u>, 79AD, Mount Vesuvius erupted near the city. The mountain spewed out great clouds of ash, smoke, and pumice, which rained down on Pompeii's citizens. Unfortunately for Pompeii, that wasn't the end of it either – next came molten lava, which buried the remaining residents 7 feet (2.1 m) deep!
- <u>August has three birthstones</u>: sardonyx, spinel, and peridot. One of the lesser-known gems, peridots come in shades from grass-green to a more earthy olive hue. They're quite a unique gem, really, and quite rare as they can only be found from two very different sources they can be formed deep in the earth and expelled to the surface along with lava, and they can be found in meteorites! It is claimed that peridots have healing powers and can protect the bearer from evil.
- There are some pretty fascinating holidays spread throughout August which are celebrated in different parts of the world. On August 1st, we have World Scout Scarf Day, as well as the Official Birthday and Coronation of the King of Tonga (try saying that in one go!). August 5th is National Underwear Day (US), August 11th is Mountain Day (Japan), August 16th is National Rum Day (US) and August 20th is World Mosquito Day. What a month!
- The US also has some pretty delicious-sounding observances for the month relating to food! In August the US celebrates National Goat Cheese Month, National Panini Month, Peach Month, and Sandwich Month.


