

## WHAT DOES THE 90-DEGREE RULE ACTUALLY MEAN?

If you see a sign that reads "90-degree rule in effect today," or something similar, the meaning is really not as ominous as it may seem. All this sign, or the helpful attendant at the pro shop, means is to please keep your golf cart on the path, except for a right angle turn across the fairway directly toward your ball and back. Rather than drive directly to your ball, it's asked that you drive straight back to the path and repeat the process each time. This helps to limit the stress on the fairway.

#### **Golf Course Rules**

Golf cart paths on both North and South Courses are for golfers playing a round of golf. To ensure everyone's safety, the following non-golfing activities are not allowed during daylight hours on the course: walking, jogging, bicycling, dog walking, fishing or non-playing golf cart rides. Daylight hours are defined as ½ hour before sunrise and ½ hour BEFORE sunset. The course will be closed to all activities 1 hour after sunset. The only exceptions would be if there is an organized activity such as night golf. [Dog walking is not permitted on the golf course at any time]. Non-golfing activities are not allowed on the North and South Courses when the courses are closed. The rules are in place for the safety of the golfers. Thank You for your cooperation.

#### <u>Living with Alligators – Information from</u> Florida Wildlife

#### Conservation Commission (FWC)

Alligators are an important part of Florida's landscape and play a valuable role in the ecology of our state's wetlands. Alligators are predators and help keep other aquatic animal populations in balance. A better understanding of the facts and information regarding these creatures will help ensure that people and alligators can continue to coexist.

#### Alligators & People

Alligators are a fundamental part of Florida's wetlands, swamps, rivers, and lakes, and they are found in all 67 counties. Florida continues to experience human population growth. Many new residents seek waterfront homes, resulting in increased interactions between people and alligators. Although most Floridians understand that we have alligators living in our state, the potential for conflict exists. Because of their predatory nature, alligators may target pets and livestock as prey.

## \*\*PLEASE KEEP YOUR PET ON A LEASH AND NEVER LEAVE PETS UNATTENDED

[\*\*Note from CL Management per the Community Rules and Regulations]

In the past 10 years, the Florida FWC has received an average of nearly 16,000 alligator-related complaints per year. Most of these complaints deal with alligators occurring in places such as backyard ponds, canals, ditches and streams, but other conflicts occur when alligators wander into garages, swimming pools and golf course ponds. Sometimes, alligators come out of the water to bask in the sun or move between wetlands. In many cases, if left alone, these alligators will eventually move on to areas away from people.

Generally, alligators less than four feet in length are not large enough to be dangerous unless handled.

\*\*One of the best things about Cypress Lakes is the wildlife... However, SAFETY FIRST, Always! Residents should educate their quests.

If you feel an alligator is aggressive or has lost its fear of humans, please call the Cypress Lakes office and Management will address this.

#### "BETWEEN THE LANES"

This month's question: "How do Traffic Law and Driving Etiquette differ?" Traffic law covers violations such as speeding or ignoring signals and typically leads to fines and penalty points. Driving Etiquette is about being courteous on the road and setting a respectful example for everyone in our community. Cypress Lakes Village is a community that includes residents, neighbors, colleagues, committee members, and social clubs—in other words, a self-contained community with features typical of village life. Practice patience, kindness, tolerance, and respect. Always be mindful of your attitude when interacting with others. Here are some key tips for respectful behavior between lanes; crucial for ensuring safety above all else. Speed Limits: 10 MPH entering and exiting the community; 15 MPH throughout the rest of the community. Construction is affecting our community's traffic patterns every day. We must all drive safely and responsibly. Proceed carefully through the Main Gate and yield to your visitors in the Visitor Lane that are approaching residences. Speeding ahead to cut someone off is both rude and careless.

<u>Clubhouse</u>, <u>Administration Building</u>, and the <u>Grill: Yield to others at the Grill.</u> Be courteous and stop as needed. Wait patiently; do not speed or honk around pedestrians or backing cars.

<u>Parking:</u> Please follow posted signs for Golf Cart or Vehicle Parking. Use Disability spots for golf carts or vehicles only if you have a Disability Placard.

<u>Tailgating:</u> Use your key card and avoid tailgating at the North Gate—it's unsafe and delays the gate mechanism. Always leave a car length between golf carts and vehicles or motorcycles.

<u>Stop Signs:</u> Observing all stop signs—whether operating a golf cart, vehicle, or motorcycle—is required for safety and courtesy. Do not ignore stop signs; stopping is mandatory. <u>Passing:</u> Never pass a golf cart, vehicle, or motorcycle on the inside lane next to the curb, as it can startle other drivers. Do not pass on bridges; remain in your lane and wait until it is safe to pass.

Let's all share social space in our Cypress Lakes Village community, by observing traffic law and practicing driving etiquette - good manners "between the lanes."






