#### Happy September 2025 RGV

A few CAPEX updates on projects that are started and or completed. We had a lot of projects in 2025 that we are wrapping up for the year. Here are the larger ones that are either completed or nearing completion.

- New community signs We should have new signs by the time you read this. They look great! They were much needed. The new signs are brighter, look 100% better than the old ones, and are cleaner looking.

- Paving The paving should also be 100% completed at this point. We have already added Phase 2 to the 2026 CAPEX list, and we will do more each year until the community is done.

We try to prepare the course for overseeding (last week of October) by getting our greens, tees, and fairways as thick and healthy as possible to receive that, because what we go into winter with is pretty much what we come out of winter with next season when we transition back to Bermuda grass. Number 2 green is coming along well and will be down to the same height of cut as all of the other greens by mid-October, when we plan on opening it for play. Tree work and irrigation leaks are an ongoing issue for us to deal with, so thank you for your understanding and patience about that. We wish you all peace and happiness as you go.

#### MAINTENENCE HOT TOPICS

#### Hello everyone,

I hope everyone finds themselves healthy and safe. Here are a few topics that I would like to make you all are aware of.

- · Pool Cleanliness- The Rec pool was just drained and hand-scrubbed of all black algae. This is a very tedious task as each spot must be treated with shock to kill the algae. The pool must then be filled and shocked with chlorine and black algaecide. Please take care when using our pools. Please wash your swimming attire, pool toys, shoes, etc. before entering our pools to avoid introducing black algae. This type of algae is extremely difficult to irradicate and is very unsightly.
- Pool deck painting- We are planning on painting the pool deck with cool paint this fall.
   Stay tuned and thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding during this process.
- · Yard waste- Please refrain from clearing out the woods your behind your home and bringing the debris to the road for maintenance to clean up. If you desire to clear out part of the woods behind your home, please push all the debris deeper into the woods.
- · Road work- Road work has started. The road leading to storage lot #1 has been completed and we are preparing for additional roads to be repaired soon. We are on schedule for the week of August 26th. Please stay tuned as we will be advising you when your street will be done so that you can park elsewhere during the 24 hours the asphalt needs to be set.




