Without a doubt, the upgrades and/or additions for all the projects we completed this year could not have been accomplished without the teamwork exhibited by our vendors, our team here, CEHOA, and most importantly, our residents. As a recap, here are the current statuses of our Capital improvements for 2025:

- Asphalt Repair and Sidewalk Replacement – Completed

- Cabanas and Pool Furniture – Completed (New pool cushions have been ordered and are awaiting delivery)
- Irrigation – Phase Two has begun (Pricing and installation)
- Lake Erosion – Completed
- Solar Blinds in Ballroom – Completed
- Clubhouse Remodel – Final Stages of Completion
- Tennis Court Landscape Upgrades - Completed
- RV Storage Area Landscaping – Completed
- Late Summer / Fall Landscaping – Completion of front landscaping and new flagpoles done

### Upcoming Projects

- Tennis Court Resurfacing and Pickleball Striping – Contracts signed; all three courts are scheduled for resurfacing (including Pickleball striping for all three)
- Fencing – Contracts submitted and signed, awaiting scheduling with the vendor
- Clubhouse Doors – Awaiting delivery and installation

November also brings us to our second Cammy's, and we encourage you to take part in honoring our residents who continue to make this community one of the best places to live in Sarasota! See our Lifestyle Director for more information as tickets are going FAST!!!!!!

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## Veteran Spotlight

**Frank Bassetti**



At just 19 years old, Frank Bassetti answered the call to serve during one of the most challenging periods in American history—the Vietnam War. On December 8, 1965, he reported to the induction center in lower Manhattan and began his service with the U.S. Army.

Frank completed basic training at Fort Gordon, Georgia, and was then assigned to the U.S. Army Hospital as a Medical Records Specialist Clerk. He served honorably for two years at Fort Gordon and received his Honorable Discharge on December 7, 1967.

Since leaving the military, Frank has remained dedicated to supporting fellow veterans. He previously served as Commander of American Legion Post 1404 in New York, and today, he continues to give back at Camelot East Village, where he maintains the Veterans Wall and helps organize Veterans Day and Memorial Day services.

We are proud to recognize Frank Bassetti as our Veteran of the Month and thank him for his unwavering service to both his country and his community.

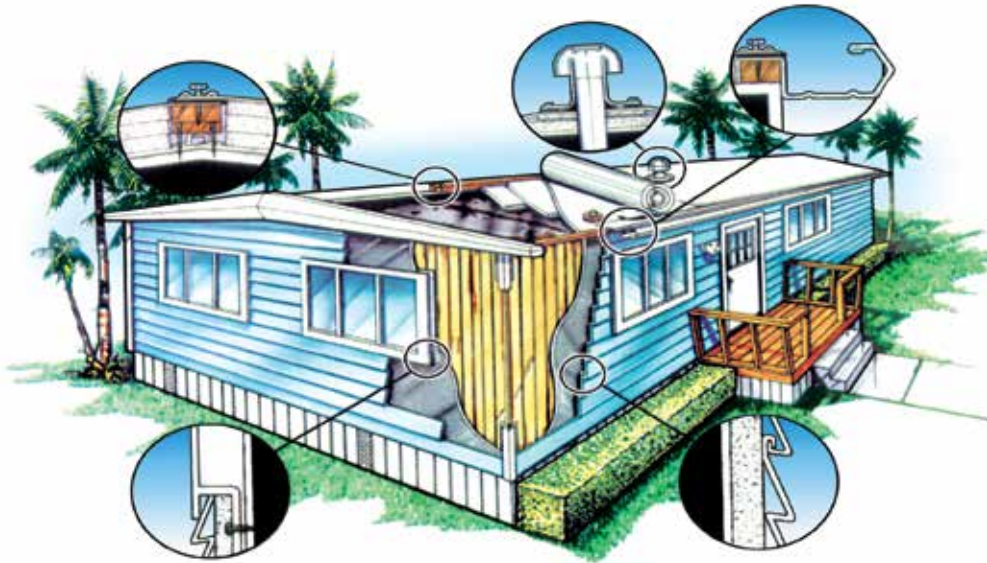


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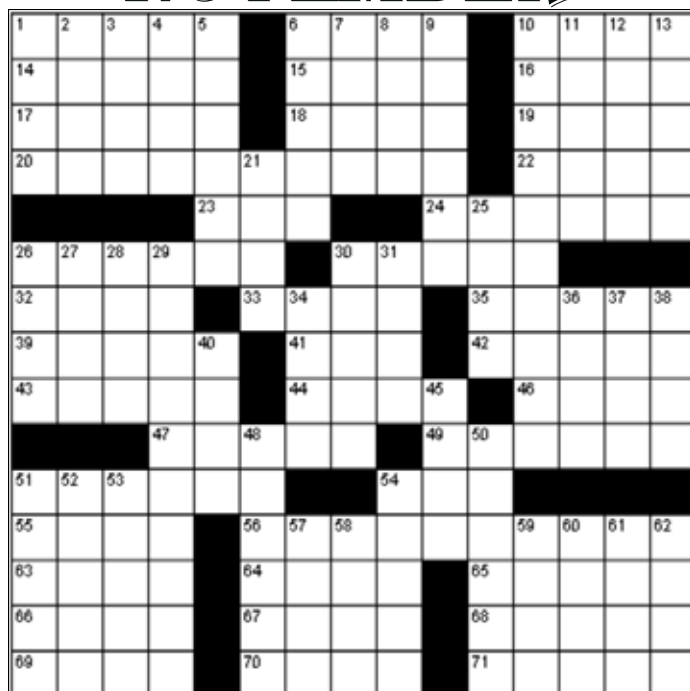
