Welcome to the start of the 2025/2026 Season. Many of the Seasonal Residents will be returning and getting back into the activities at HRV. Don't forget to welcome our new homeowners by introducing yourself and inviting them to join in the various events. As the season kicks off there are many things planned already but Pat continues to work on events.

Hurricane Season extends to the 1st of December. We have been fortunate so far this year but, please stay aware and prepared if a storm is headed in our direction. They can be far reaching so don't discount the potential threat. Please check on your neighbors and lend a helping hand if you are able. It means more to those in need than you can imagine.

Resident October 25/26 Car Stickers are available. Residents currently on site will get a sticker in your mailbox. Seasonal residents please obtain your 25/26 car sticker when you check in, update your information, and provide a copy of your homes title/registration if you have not already done so. If you do not receive a sticker, please check with the Office. Have a copy of the current registration for boat/trailer going into Storage. Gate stickers/codes are for Resident use only and are not to be given to others. Once someone sells their home at HRV, they are no longer entitled to come in to use HRV Amenities.

- There is no solicitation on HRV property. If you have someone knock on your door, please contact the office. They will be escorted off the property. Solicitation by residents is also prohibited.
- Boat slips may not be sublet. If you sell your boat/home the slip assignment does not go with either. There is a wait list for boat slips, and new assignments will be made based on the list and availability.
- The speed limit is 10mph, please, observe it. Stop signs mean STOP. This includes golf carts and bicycles also.
- Overnight visitors are to be registered with the Office and obtain a pass.
- Improvements to your home/site require park approval prior to the project start. Contact the office to request a review. Lake County permits are REQUIRED for most projects. Be sure your vendor complies.

Park Improvements – White vinyl fencing and maintenance building face-lift. The interior fencing has been completed. Exterior fencing is still to be done. Maintenance building is an amazing transformation. Café renovations are with the General Contractor. Street Signs are in progress, but Lake County has not provided house numbers yet. You will be notified as soon as HRV receives the information. Keycode entry gates have been installed at both entrances to the outdoor pool. They are required by Lake County! Several A/C units in buildings have been replaced. Maintenance has all the materials and is currently working on rebuilding the rolling dumpsters one by one. Shuffleboard courts have some new benches. The funding for the final few benches will be requested in 2026 budgets. Cove's construction department is working on several other projects. Information will be shared once things are more concrete.

Thank you for making HOLIDAY RV your home, participating in the activities and utilizing the amenities. Friendships are made by joining in. Take advantage of the many activities to broaden your circle.

Kevin is originally from Continental, Ohio, entered the National Guard after high school for "the College Tuition." He attended Basic Training for Infantry at Fort Benning, Georgia. Kevin attended Bowling Green State University for 2 years. With the National Guard he worked a weekend month and for 2 weeks in the summer. He did do 3 weeks of cold weather training at a Winter Survival School, in 1990 or 1991, at Fort Greely, AK. He actually was out in the elements with a tent and supplies for about 2 weeks and "it was cold". He also went to England for 2 weeks in 1999 to train with the British.

2001, Kevin was away at an ANCO - Advanced Non Commissioned Officer School, once he got home, he was deployed to Fort Knox for Post Security for the next year.

Kevin, a First Sargent, E-8, was activated and deployed to Germany for training then to Kosovo for UN Peacekeeping Missions as Squadron Leader for Safety and Civility. For this deployment he drew hostile combat pay.

After being home for a month on terminal leave, Hurricane Katrina happened. He was deployed to the Super Dome, then traveled around the flood waters on boats in East Orleans rescuing people in homes, those that would go.

Kevin retired from the National Guard in June 2007.

Kevin worked as a Parts Manager at a GM Dealership. He retired in 2020. He came to Holiday as he had family living here. He bought a place and became a full time resident in the fall of 2020.

Kevin has 3 daughters and 4 grandchildren. He plays softball and coaches. He and his girlfriend, Tina Pion are busy around the park.






