- Paving- The seal coating is next. If it is not completed already, this should be done this month. We were waiting for the west clubhouse to be completed. The following roads will be seal-coated: La Costa Drive, Torrey Pines Drive, Pebble Beach Road, and Oak mount Avenue.
 - West Clubhouse- The renovation is moving along nicely and will be completed soon, if not already. We will be having our re-grand opening soon. Please stay tuned for more details.
- Waste Management- We are still waiting on delivery dates and assembly dates for the new Roller garbage container for each home. They will be assembled onsite and delivered to each of you. They have ordered enough. I am waiting for the vendor to tell me when the new containers will be delivered and assembled.
- Therapy pool- The therapy pool has some leaks and will need to be down until the work can be completed. We will keep you posted as we know more details. Maybe the pool is already completed by now. In case it is not, at least you will be aware.

We will work with the vendor to get the work completed promptly.

RV Storage

It has been six months since we started the new RV/Camper/Trailer/Boat system, and we are finding a few glitches in the plan. 

We know there is some confusion on events here is a breakdown:

HOA Events

HOA-sponsored events are organized and managed entirely by the Homeowners Association. From planning and ticket sales to set-up, staffing, and clean-up, the HOA oversees every aspect of the event. All proceeds from ticket sales are collected by the HOA and go directly toward funding the event or future community activities.

Private events

Are hosted by individual residents who are fully responsible for the planning and execution of their gathering. This includes all decorations, set-up, staffing, and clean-up. Residents must submit a deposit to reserve the space, which is provided in its current condition ("as is"). These events are not affiliated with the HOA or Cove, and the host is expected to restore the area to its original state following the event.

Cove Events

Cove-hosted events are fully organized and executed by the Cove team. We handle every detail, from the initial concept and promotion to the final clean-up. Residents can simply attend and enjoy without any responsibility for planning or logistics. These events are part of our ongoing commitment to building community and providing engaging, stress-free experiences for our residents.

This is a friendly reminder regarding the use of the clubhouse. When renting the space, please remember that it is provided as-is, and we kindly ask that it be returned in the same condition.

Specifically, we ask that you do not remove or alter the curtains on the stage or move any items on the Fallen Soldier table. These elements are part of the permanent setup and hold significant meaning and purpose.

Additionally, when rearranging tables for your event, please ensure they are returned to their original positions before you leave. Diagrams showing the correct table setup are posted on both sides of the clubhouse near the AC thermostats for your convenience.

Please understand that when items are moved or taken down—especially the stage curtains—it creates a considerable amount of additional work for our staff to restore the room.

I hope this message finds you well, healthy, and safe. Here are a few important community updates and reminders to keep you informed:

Page 1 Therapy Pool Update

The therapy pool was recently inspected and found to be leaking in several areas. We are actively working on scheduling the necessary repairs. Additional testing is required to determine the severity of the issue, so we appreciate your patience during this process.

For safety reasons, the pool will remain closed until further notice. Pool heaters have also been adjusted to prepare for the cooler weather, so please allow time for temperatures to stabilize once reopened.

Pool Deck Painting

We are planning to repaint the pool deck this fall using a "cool paint" finish. We'll share more details and timelines soon. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding as we complete this project.

Yard Waste Disposal

Thank you for your continued efforts in keeping our community clean! Using containers and bags for yard waste has made a big difference. Even simple practices, like how yard waste is stacked, help make our maintenance process safer and more efficient.

Road Work Progress

This year's road work is now complete, with the exception of sealcoating. We will notify residents ahead of time before sealcoating begins. Thank you again for your patience and cooperation throughout the repairs.

Amenities Maintenance

Ongoing improvements are being made around our community, including pressure washing near buildings and repainting around the sports courts. We appreciate your patience as we continue to beautify our shared spaces.

Mailbox Care

All community mailboxes have been treated with a bleach solution. If your mailbox was already clean, you'll likely notice it looks even brighter after recent rain. For those affected by algae, the sun and bleach will help clear the growth, making it easier to clean with a rag or soft brush.

Mailboxes are often overlooked, but they're one of the first things visitors and guests see when entering our community. To maintain their appearance, we recommend misting them every couple of weeks with a 20% bleach solution. This helps prevent algae and keeps them looking fresh—rain will do the rest!




