

Strawberry Slab Pie

Preheat oven to 450° F.

1 (11 oz.) package refrigerated pie crust

Turn both pie crusts out on a lightly floured surface and stack one on top of the other. Roll them out to roughly a 12x17-inch rectangle, then transfer crust to a large baking sheet (10x15-inches).

Tuck any excess crust under itself, then crimp edges as desired, pricking the bottom and sides all over with a fork. Place baking sheet in oven and bake for 9-11 minutes, or until golden brown, then remove from oven and let cool.



32 oz. fresh strawberries, hulled and sliced

6 oz. strawberry jelllo

1/3 cup cornstarch

Garnish w/frozen whipped topping or whipped cream

2 1/2 cups lemon lime soda (we used sprite)

1 1/4 cups sugar

1 tablespoon lemon juice

In a large saucepan over medium heat, whisk together jello packet, sugar and cornstarch, then pour in sprite and lemon juice.

Bring mixture to a boil, stirring until thickened, remove from heat, cool 10-15 minutes.

Once crust has cooled, arrange sliced strawberries on top, then pour (cooled) filling carefully on top.

Refrigerate slab pie for 2+ hours, or until set, then slice, serve and enjoy.






