As we enter another holiday season for our community, I am very pleased with the progress we have accomplished this past year, from the newly dedicated flagpoles to our veterans of the community, the "Cammy Awards" honoring those residents who exemplify the values we at Cove hold dear, to all the great activities that have been presented by our HOA and our Lifestyle team and ambassadors, to our residents who are actively engaging in these activities, and last but certainly not least, the upgrades and overall community spirit I encounter throughout the community. As we close out the year, here is the final status of our Capital improvements for 2025:

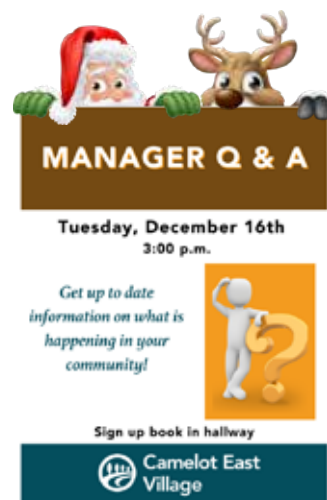
- Asphalt Repair and Sidewalk Replacement – Completed
- Ballroom Flooring – Completed
- Cabanas and Pool Furniture – Completed (New pool cushions have been ordered and are awaiting delivery)
- Irrigation – Phase 3 Installation of all new wiring and controllers – All work to be completed by the end of December
- Lake Erosion – Completed
- Solar Blinds in Ballroom – Completed
- Clubhouse Remodel – Complete, awaiting new furniture for rooms and Certificate of Occupancy
- Tennis Court Landscape Upgrades - Work began December 1, 2025, and is in the process of completion
- RV Storage Area Landscaping – Completed – Upgrades for lighting and cameras set for 2026
- Late Summer / Fall Landscaping – Completed front landscaping and new flagpoles
- Seven Oaks Fencing – Awaiting scheduling; deposits have all been submitted and materials ordered – completion by the end of December
- Clubhouse Doors (Pool) – Deposits submitted – Awaiting scheduling and installation

2025 has been an exciting year as we have made many improvements around the community and will continue to move forward with new projects that will benefit the community and residents alike. 2025 also saw the new creation of the Veterans Breakfast Club; this newly formed activity will be for our veterans in the community. The breakfast club will begin in January and will be held every month from January to May and September to December, where each month we will have an activity open to our veterans free of charge. In addition, any donations collected for these monthly events will go to DAV (Disabled American Veterans). For more information, feel free to reach out to the Lifestyle Department.

As we end the year, the quote that resonates with me comes from a modern anonymous quote, and its saying is one that will resonate with all in our community as we gear up for the holiday season:
