

Important Update: Clubhouse & Community Center Deposit Policy

Beginning January 2026, a \$200 deposit will be required for all events and activities held in the Clubhouses. This applies to every clubhouse booking with the exception of exercise classes, as those classes are fully hosted and funded by Cove. This is just a deposit and will be returned once your event is over if the room was left exactly the way it was found.

Please note that the Community Center will continue not to require a deposit for reservations.

We understand that deposit requirements have not always been strictly enforced in the past. However, to ensure consistent use and care of our facilities, the updated policy will go into effect in 2026.



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


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
