

## Maintenance Corner

Just a friendly reminder: max speed limit in the park is a cool 10 mph!

Kindly keep out the gate crashers! If anyone needs a hand, just point them to the number on the gate pad.

Cardboard should be flattened before disposal in the receptacle. All items must be placed inside the dumpsters and not left scattered around the vicinity.

Reminder: Everyone is responsible in raking your lot. Maintenance will pick up every Monday and Thursday. Be sure items are bagged, in front of your unit close to the roadside for pick-up.

Large household items are PROHIBITED in dumpsters. TV's, air conditioners, refrigerators, LP tanks, car tires, golf cart tires, or Furniture such as recliner, loveseat, mattress, lawn furniture, lamps, tables, appliances, and any other large items MUST be taken to Polk County Landfill.
