I have known Jeannie O'Dell for a few years, but there is a great deal about her that I have never known. Jeannie and her husband Allen moved here to Strawberry Ridge 7 years ago. Unfortunately, Allen passed away 5 years ago. That same year Jeannie lost her mother also. They lived here full-time the first 3 years, but Jeannie then became a snowbird, spending the summer months in Virginia.

Jeannie and Allen had both had previous marriages but were still blessed with 39 years of happiness together. Allen had 2 children and Jeannie had 1 son, David, who passed away at the young age of 50. In her spare time Jeannie enjoys reading, Bible studies, and volunteering. Here at SR she is on the board of the Benevolent Fund. She also teaches a Bible study at an area retirement community. Jeannie is the head of the Garden Gals, a group that works on yards here in the park for donations to the Benevolent Fund. She truly lives a life of service. In large part this is due to her becoming a Christian in 1982. Up in Virginia she is also on 2 environmental boards and is the Clinch River Valley Initiative treasurer.

Jeannie has always been interested in environmental issues. She was still in her 20's when she was hired as the first female Surface Coal Mining Inspector in Alabama. She enjoyed this position for 2 years, until it became dangerous. Some of the mines didn't appreciate her attention to the rules, and her fellow inspectors started to hear that there was a contract out on her! In 1980 she went to work for the US Dept of the Interior. (If you run into her, ask her about her yellow bikini.) She was also on the Alabama Conservancy Board and was the recycling chairman. She and Allen both took a Christian budgeting course and were budget coaches, mainly working with church congregations.

Jeannie enjoys living at SR because she has many good friends here. She also appreciates the sense of security and strong sense of community. She is close to family and her church here as well. When asked if she has suggestions for living a happy life, Jeannie suggests living for God #1, and **choose** to be happy. Retirement is the beginning of a new life! We are blessed to have Jeannie as part of our community.


SBR Veterans are an inactive group. We are here if needed. We plan to start getting together

Check with the Strawberry Ridge Village Lending Closet, located at the Clubhouse, which provides medical equipment to our residents upon request. This service is at no cost to our residents, is a great cost-saving measure, and the loan of the equipment has no time limit. You may keep the equipment if it is necessary.

We have wheelchairs, transfer chairs, crutches, canes, walkers, bed rails, potty chairs, and shower chairs. These items are available for all our residents to borrow. Donations of the mentioned items are also accepted. There are limits on the type of supplies we can accept. We cannot accept respiratory items, diapers, walking boots, medications, stability belts or other disposable items. All that we ask is that when returning borrowed items or donating items please ensure that all items have been cleaned and are fully operational. The volunteer staff does not have the ability to clean or repair any items. Presently, the Lending Closet is in short supply of Rollator Walkers. Any donation of or return of one no longer needed would be appreciated.

A message to Strawberry Ridge Contributors, Donors, and all kind and generous people! The Strawberry Ridge Benevolent Fund has operated many years, providing food and services to needy residents in the Village. We exist to serve our neighbors and have been able to do this because of your generous hearts. Thank you so much!

We have recently been notified by the Office that, for the foreseeable future, we will not be able to store food of any kind in either the Clubhouse Pantry or the Activity Center because of rodent and insect infestations. As a result, we will be clearing out the Pantry and donating the food stored there to other ministries. Because of the problem of the infestations, beneficent folks have been bringing donated items to the Beckmeyers to distribute to those in need, and we appreciate this so much. Nevertheless, the tremendous amount of food and other items that have been donated has overwhelmed our ability to pass them on to our recipients. So, until we send out a specific appeal to the community, please do not bring any more food and other items to the Beckmeyers

We do not want to discourage anyone who has been contributing food and/or money to the Benevolent Fund. We just no longer have a way to store and distribute food to our recipients in the same manner that we have in the past. Our goal is to continue to support our recipients in every way that we can provide services to them, so, instead of food, a monetary donation (check or cash) would be appreciated. 


