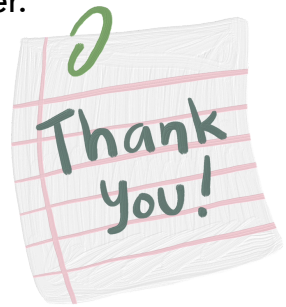
As we welcome the month of April, we'd like to share a few important reminders and extend our appreciation to our wonderful community.

# I LIVE TO EAT

When I was living in the Pacific NW I would call my mom and dad, (who moved to Sarasota in the early 90"s) to say I needed a break from the gray, damp weather. I would come here and one of the first places we'd go to dinner was Bangkok restaurant. My mom was a notoriously picky eater so I would never have guessed that she would eat Thai food. But the fried tofu was her jam.

The fact that the restaurant has been around for over 40(!) years speaks volumes about the food and service. It is exquisitely decorated with objects imported from Thailand and even the servers dresses are authentic.

At my most recent visit I was still happy that the quality of food was excellent and the service cheerful. I had rice noodles with vegetables and pork. Many of the other diners had fried rice bowls. All the dishes received praise and thoughts of a return visit.

If you are reluctant to try Thai food, this is a good place to start. The prices are very reasonable and you can get any level of spice that suits you. There is a large menu so everyone can have an interesting dish. There is even a Thai version of a banana split on the dessert menu. While the outside looks non-descript and is in a strip mall, when you enter you are transported to Thailand. Even the rice comes in a beautiful silver bowl.

The restaurant was at full capacity with people waiting when we left which is a good indicator that the food is delicious. If you go there, maybe have the fried tofu in honor of my mom.



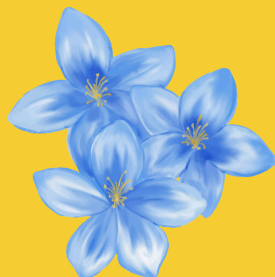


