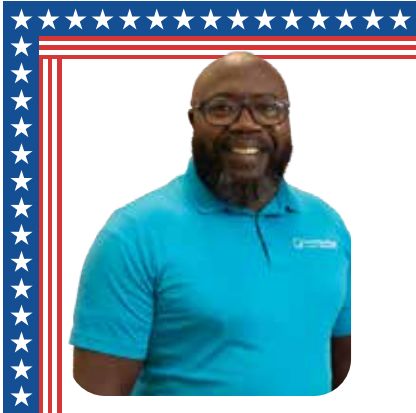

Last month's Manger's meeting discussed the following updates: Overview provided below

- Irrigation Project Updates – Phase 2 is in process awaiting approval for the quotes that were submitted.
- Irrigation being handled by residents – Discussion on proper procedures of handling irrigation.
- Bocce Court awning updates – Bids have been submitted and await to be awarded to the vendor.
- Perimeter Fencing – Quotes have been submitted and will be moving forward with the next section of fencing.
- Asphalt replacement – Location of asphalt replacement will be from the Entry of community, down Queensbury, and stopping at Lichfield, in addition to several areas that will be repaired in the community.
- Ring Central – New phone lines have been installed in the offices.
- Sound system for Ballroom – Quotes received and moving forward with new system.
- Solar lighting – Quote received and moving forward with new lighting
- Cornhole boards for community – Purchased and placed at the shuffleboard courts 4-7.
- Cabinets for card room – Received and placed 2 new cabinets in the card room for proper storage of items.
- Sod replacement for homes along Wellfleet – Provided the locations of the homes that will receive sod In the upcoming month.

Please remember the following fees have been updated:

- Storage fees: \$85.00
- Delinquency fee (Late fee): \$75.00*
- Returned Check fee (NSF): \$75.00
- Lot Maint Surcharge: \$50.00per hour / Minimum 3hr charge
- Clubhouse User fee: \$200.00
- Clubhouse Deposit: \$100.00

*Lot fees are due on the 1st of each month with a grace period of 10 days. Any payment received after the 10th of the month is considered late and a fee of \$75.00 will be applied. If you require assistance, or if you are having issues related to lot payments please reach out to the office.
