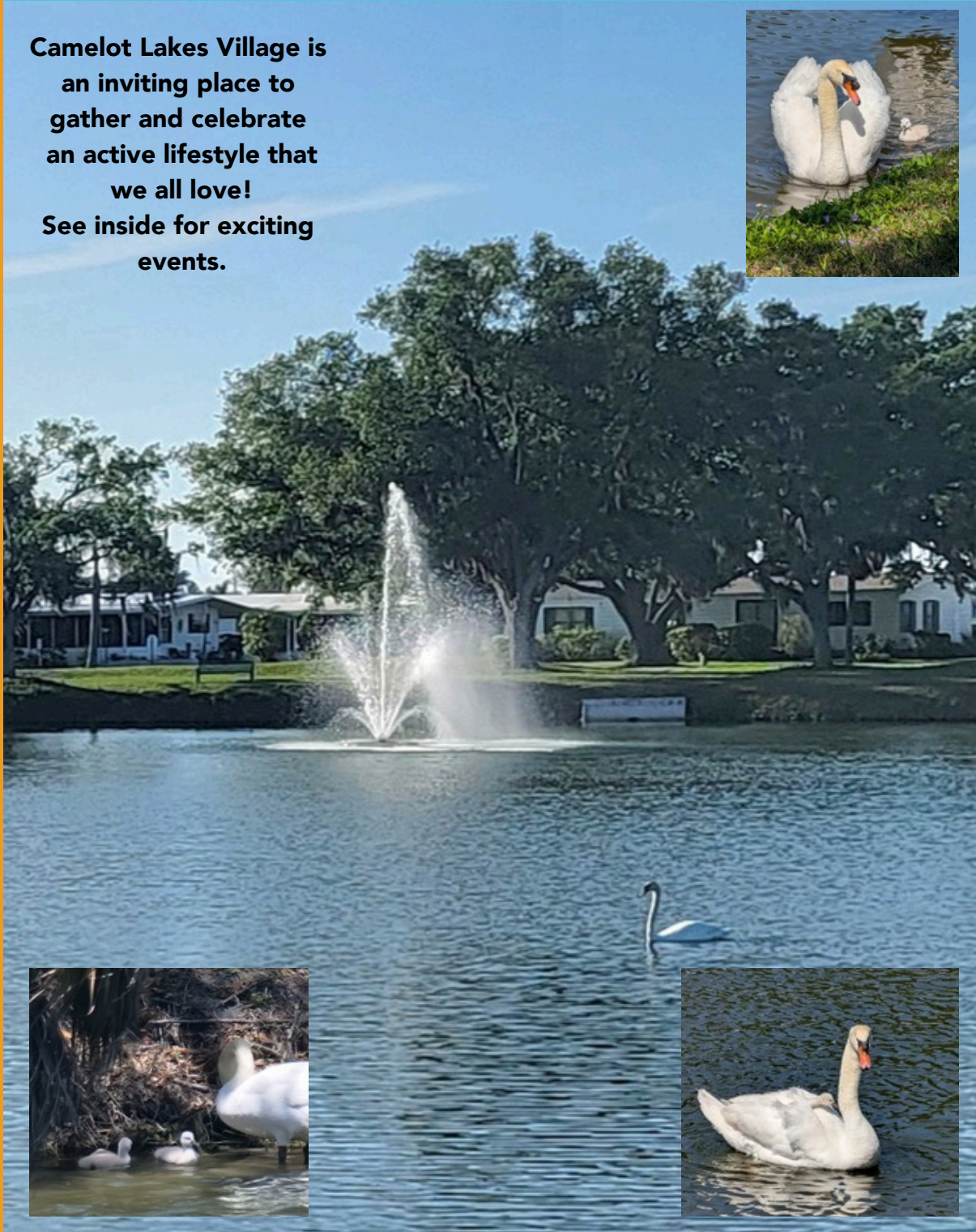

Our server, Lily, was knowledgeable and great at herding the cats that comprised our table. Several of the diners ordered wings with a mild sauce.

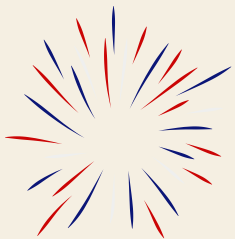

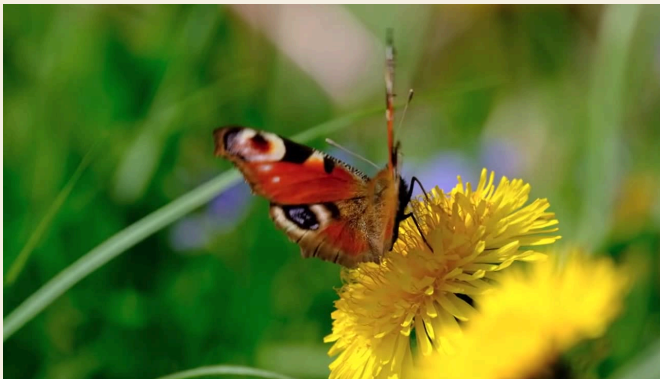
