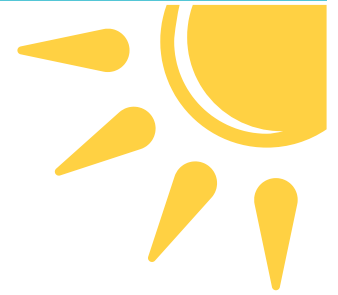

This May's Managers Meeting discussed the following updates: Overview provided below

Irrigation Project Updates – Phase 2 is in process, awaiting approval for the quotes that were submitted.

Bocce Court awning updates – Contract has been awarded and permitting is underway. Prep will begin for the Bocce court area this month.

Perimeter Fencing – Final quotes have been submitted and are under review.

Asphalt replacement – Received all requested bids for the work requested.

Ring Central – New phone lines have been installed in the offices; updated processes when contacting the office follow prompts.

Sound system for Ballroom – Submitted for approval to move forward. Deposit submitted to begin pre-installation.

Solar lighting – Quotes received from all vendors and currently under review.

Buried Irrigation and sprinkler heads – We will begin the process of uncovering and identifying the sprinkler heads in the Wellfleet area.

Veterans wall – Updated wall for our veterans and residents in the community.

Sod Replacement for homes along Wellfleet – Installation has begun for the homes on Wellfleet identified.

Discussion of additional Golf Cart Parking – Discussion of additional parking for golf carts in the community.

From the desk of the HOA President:

As we all begin settling in as year-round residents, we move forward without many of our friends and neighbors. I have recently been asked about the breakdown of the 432 homes in our community regarding full-time and seasonal residency. Currently, there are 289 full-time residents (67%) and 143 seasonal residents (33%). With 289 of us here for the summer season, I am confident that we can continue to have fun and create memories together.

Regarding the Board of Directors, I would like to welcome our newest Board member, Arlene Kretzmer. Arlene joins our team as Member at Large, Membership, replacing Jonna Garber who resigned in May. Arlene has been an HOA member for many years and has served on our Board in various capacities. She has worked directly with me in supporting the Board, volunteering her time to assist with HOA membership sales as well as social and event leadership. Her experience, resident relations skills, and deep CE HOA knowledge will be incredibly valuable to all of us moving forward.

Additionally, our annual insurance coverages required by Florida Law for our HOA were paid in May. The consolidated total cost for insurance and the bond this year was \$4,962.00. The original invoice we received for 2026-2027 was \$6,063.00, which the Board disputed as it represented a significant increase over last year. We contacted other agencies for quotes and worked closely with our current agency. Ultimately, we were able to reduce the amount by \$1,100.00 after a two-month process. While \$1,100 may not seem like a vast sum to some, it represents the equivalent of 27 additional HOA memberships. I want to assure you that the Board works diligently behind the scenes on these types of protective measures for our association and community.

We will continue to post community updates and HOA announcements throughout the summer via our HOA Facebook page, which is available to all members.
