MAINTENANCE HOT TOPICS

Hello, I hope everyone is doing well. Please take a few minutes to read a few topics below.

- Alligators- As the mating season arrives, I encourage everyone to be cautious when near our ponds. If you spot an alligator that does not "run away" from you, please call the main office and report it. PLEASE DO NOT FEED THE GATORS. Doing so creates a dangerous hazard for everyone and imposes a death sentence on the animal. Gators that do not retreat are considered dangerous and will in most cases be dispatched by FWC.**
- Leashed Pets- Please always keep your pets on leash when walking the community. Please use caution when near or around any of our ponds as Alligator mating season is upon us.**
- Dog waste- simply put, please pick up after your dogs. The lawn company is running over your dog waste- and having to wash their machinery daily. Your neighbors are stepping on it in the dog parks. Some of you are leaving your dog bags along trails instead of placing them in the dog poop stations or taking it home and placing it in your dumpster. Please folks, let's be responsible pet owners and be considerate of everyone else.**
- Pool lift- The pool lift is on schedule for repair and should be up and running very soon.**
- Sports Courts- We are making progress with this project and should be hearing good news soon.**
- Water Valves- 14 water main gate valves to be replaced this summer. This should make a huge impact on the number of water shutdowns in the community. As we will be able to isolate many more sections of homes to make repairs and not have to shut down the entire community.**
- Trespassers in our community- If you notice anyone that you know does not belong to our community, please call the main office Monday through Friday 9am-5pm. During after hours, weekends, and holidays please call the after-hours emergency number (352-456-9280), and I will notify our Courtesy Patrol. They will address any issues as directed by management up to and including calling 911.**
- BIOHAZARD-For the health and safety of all residents and staff, biohazard waste containers have been placed in the handicap restroom areas. In the event you have an "accident", we kindly ask that you clean up as best you can and dispose of bodily waste materials in these containers. This includes items related to soiled personal care products, and any other bodily waste items. We kindly ask all residents to use these designated biohazard containers to help maintain a clean, sanitary, and safe environment for everyone in our community. Thank you for your cooperation and consideration**

On the golf course the transitioning of the overseeded areas is happening more quickly now and we are starting to apply product to control those nasty weeds like Goosegrass that has been an ongoing problem for us. We are not alone other courses are having the same issues, it is a weed that is hard to control. That said, when we apply those control products it will basically kill the overseed that remains so the greens tees and fairways will look a little patchy. Bermuda grass starts to grow more when night time temperatures start staying consistently above 70 degrees.

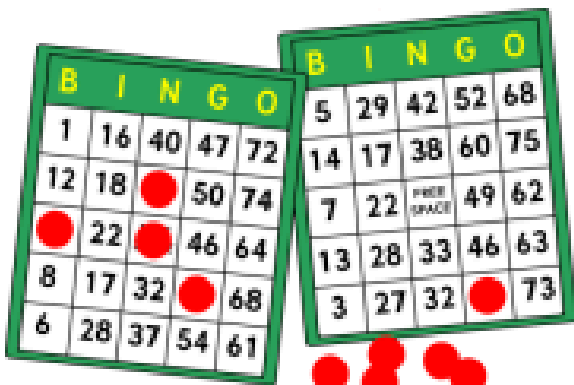
OCALA FORT KING LIONS CLUB HOSTS POKER TOURNAMENT

Recently, the Ocala Fort King Lions Club held a Texas Hold'Em poker tournament in the clubhouse of Rolling Greens Village. The event was a fundraiser for the Lions Lair, a storage container full of durable medical equipment that is available for loan. An unexpected need arose and the poker event was piggybacked with an additional fundraiser for the children of Ocala's Florida Center for the Blind to offer scholarships to the children for their summer camp. The summer camp experience is important for the kids who are blind or have impaired vision. The field trips allow them to experience and learn important lessons that cannot be taught in the classroom. The Ocala Fort King Lions Club voted to match the amount of the funds that were raised. At the poker tournament, add-on chips, re-buy chips and a prize raffle were conducted and raised enough money to fund summer camp for the children aged 5 to 13.

The tournament attracted 37 players. There were four tables at the start. Cash payout for the top 5 places totalled \$1,000. Pizza was supplied by Papa John's. At the final table the top 3 winners were Pete Vladyka, 1st place; Lion Dianne Wieckert, 2nd place; and Anissa Periboni 3rd place. Anissa is Director of the Florida Center for the Blind and a novice poker player.

Thanks to the generous poker players who supported this fundraising event, the Lions who volunteered to work at the event, the manager of Papa John's on Silver Springs Boulevard who donated pizza for everyone, and to Dave Uran for the venue at Rolling Greens Village, a Cove Community.

The Lions' motto is **We Serve** and our slogan is **Where There's a Need, There's a Lion**. Anyone who is interested in joining the Lions Club is invited to attend a meeting. We meet every Wednesday morning at 8:00 a.m. in the west clubhouse at Rolling Greens Village, 2026 Pebble Beach Road, Ocala, FL. Breakfast is supplied by Kim's Catering. 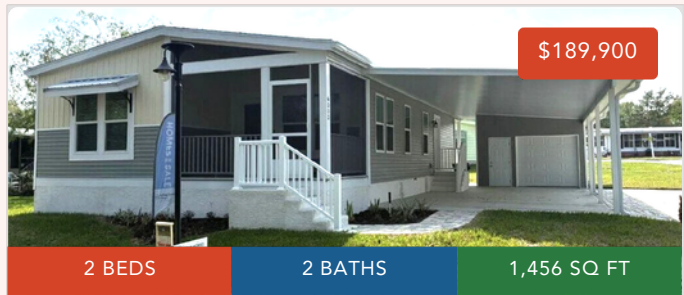

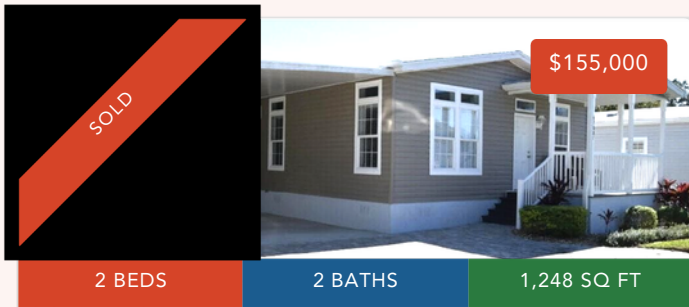
