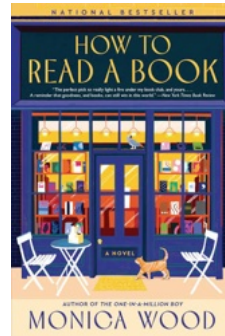

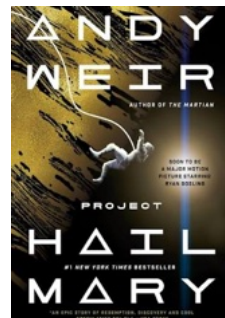
# Book Club

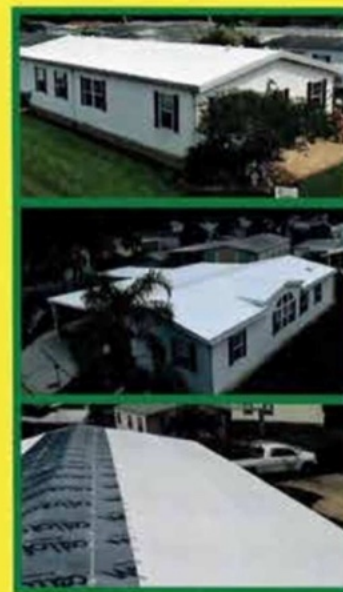
