I would like to remind everyone that we are now entering the peak of Hurricane season, so be sure you have all the essentials and a Hurricane preparedness plan in place in the event a major storm effects our area. The hurricane preparedness meeting held in July provided our residents some guidance for our community, as well as understanding our local county regulations in the event a storm effects our area. Any resident that would like a copy of what was discussed in the meeting, feel free to reach out the office.

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS:

Irrigation Project Updates – Contracts and Project Agreement have been set, pre-con meeting to discuss the scope of work and start date.

Bocce Court awning updates – Awaiting County Approval of building plans for awning.

Perimeter Fencing – Contract and Projects agreement set. Date TBD

Asphalt replacement – Contract and Project agreement set. Work to be schedule in the next 3-4 weeks covers all of Queensbury (Ingress /Egress) to Litchfield and several minor locations for repairs.

Ring Central – Completed.

Sound system for Ballroom – Contracts and Projects agreement set, work scheduled to begin in the next few weeks.

Solar lighting – Contract and Project agreement set, work scheduled to begin August 10th. Lighting around the entire perimeter of the lake and Aylesbury Lane.

Veterans wall – Completed.

Sod Replacement for homes along Wellfleet – Installation Completed. Will begin mowing mid-August.

Discussion of additional Golf Cart Parking – Currently in discussion.

Security Cameras – Installation Complete - cameras installed at the WWTP, Dog Park, Clubhouse and all rooms, RV Area.

I would also like to take this opportunity to introduce a new way of paying your monthly lot fees, you can now pay your monthly fees by credit card, if you have a resident portal account! Any resident interested in utilizing the resident portal to pay by credit or debit, in addition to our new credit card processing, you can also set up payment arrangements, in the event you have issues and you need to stretch a payment. This can now be done through the resident portal, and we encourage any resident who is interested, to stop by the office for your own login information. We encourage all our residents to take advantage of this new feature in paying your monthly amounts.

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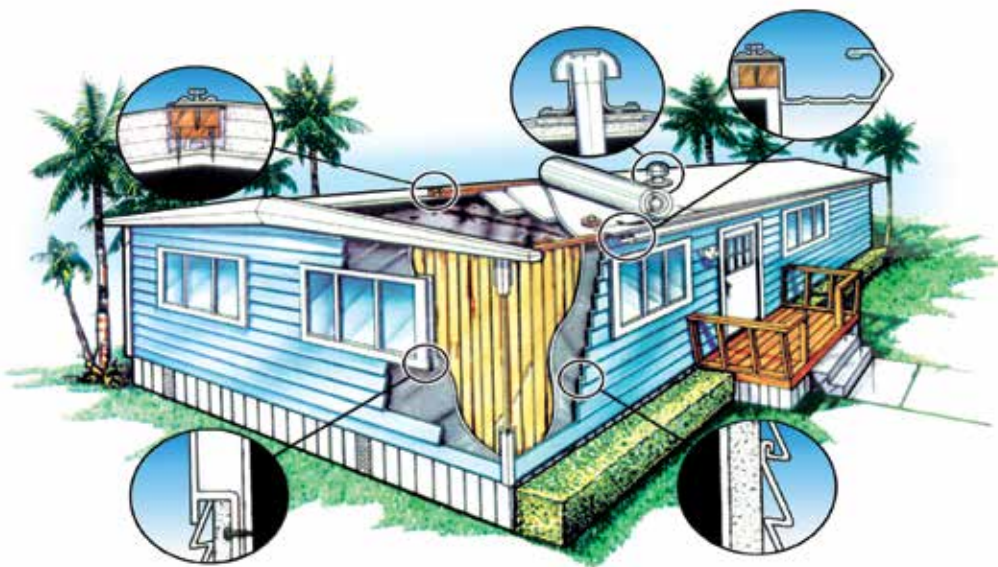

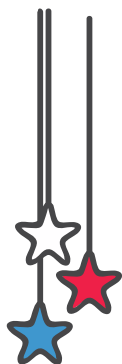

Dear HOA Members and Residents,

I hope this email finds you safe, especially those who have returned to their seasonal homes. The scorching heat, drought, and numerous brush fires caused great concern during the month of July. Our thoughts and prayers go out to everyone in Canada and the US who may have been affected by this terrible situation. Let's hope for a much calmer August.

We finally received some rain here in the community during the first few weeks of July. This has raised the water level in our lake, brought some green back into our yards, and added color to our plants. Let's hope we continue to receive rain showers for the remainder of the month.

The community as a whole has been very quiet lately. I believe this is due to the extreme heat, as the majority of our year-round residents are remaining indoors or attending the weekly events at the air-conditioned clubhouse. Due to temperatures ranging between 90 and 100 degrees, pool activity has been minimal, as an hour or two is more than enough time in the sun.

Our social calendar, led by Joseph Reiss/VP 1 over the summer, has remained active. Those who stayed year-round have enjoyed a number of HOA social events and joint events with Cove during June and July. Our By-Laws recognize this as an acceptable number of directors, and we are managing our responsibilities effectively. Next February, we will hold our annual elections again. At that time, 3 of the current positions will be expiring, and we will need to fill them. All nominated individuals must be HOA members. It is important that we begin focusing on filling these positions, with the goal of potentially having 7 board directors in place again. While 2027 may seem far off, this year has flown by. Please think about running for a position and supporting your fellow members at the board level. Starting in August, we will be providing information to define each role, explain director responsibilities, and set clear time expectations.

Lastly, we now have 245 current HOA members. A big thank you to everyone who has joined, and please note that we continue to accept additional membership requests. Your support is greatly appreciated!

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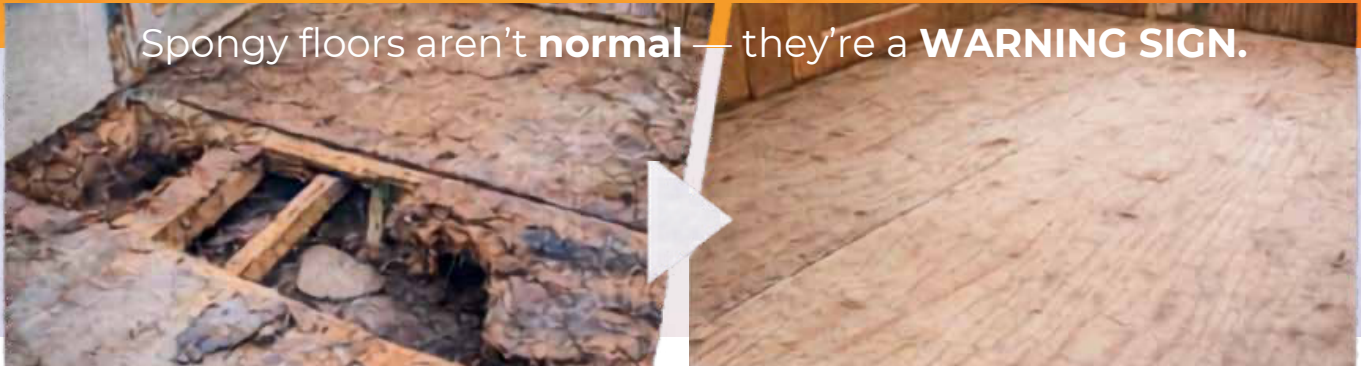

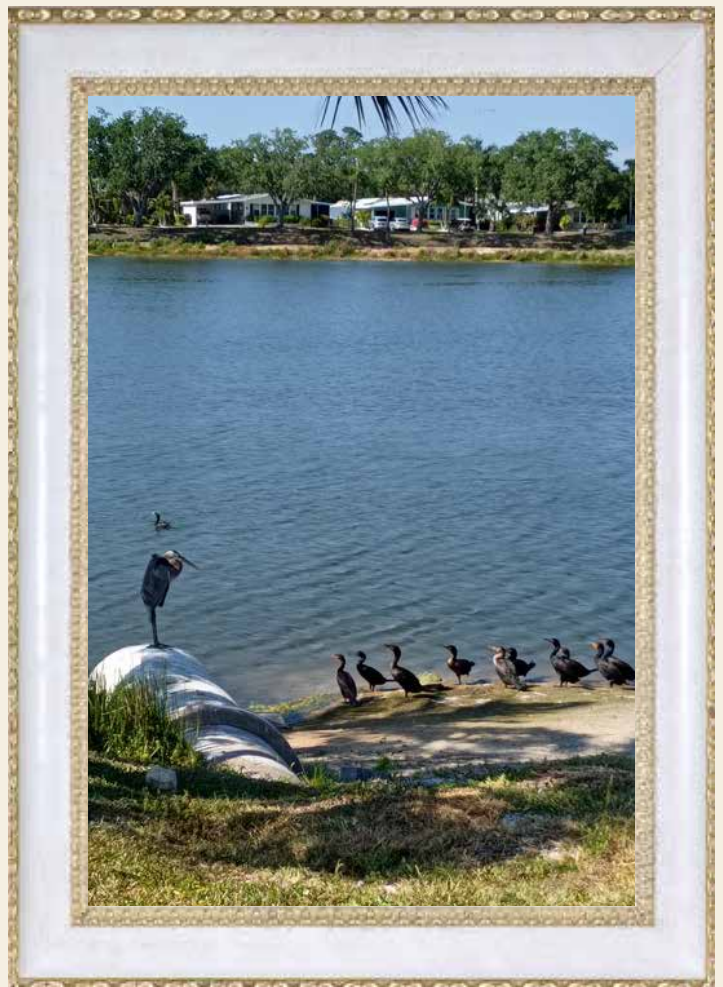
