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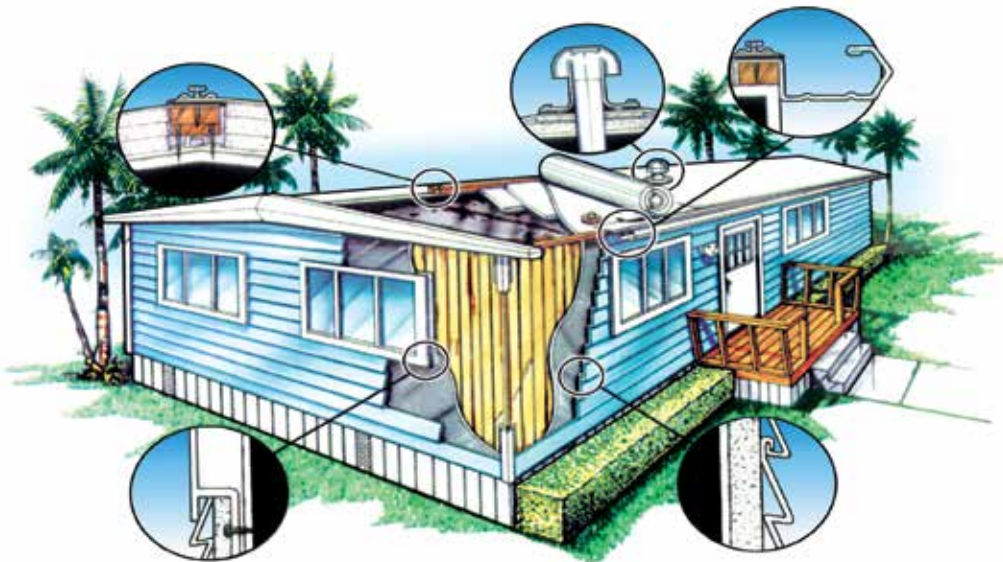

From the Desk of your HOA President,

Dear HOA members and residents,

June is here and so are hot summer days at Camelot East. Things seem much quieter and relaxed during this time of year here in the community. June has brought temperatures in the high 90s and little rain, which we need desperately; however, the blue skies and sunshine remain for us to enjoy.

Our HOA membership numbers continue to grow, with 241 members now on board. The recent membership drive that took place in May has brought new awareness to our goal of 300 members. It also helps that Arlene Kretzmer is now on the board, leading our membership efforts. I would like to thank the 20 residents who joined in the month of May. If you have not yet joined, we would welcome and appreciate your consideration to do so to help us meet our goal.

As an update, the board is pleased to announce that we are now accepting electronic payments for both our event ticket sales and HOA membership. The HOA recently made a banking change. We will now be banking with Chase Bank in the future. Chase offers us many enhancements and efficiencies that we did not have at PNC. I would like to thank Jennifer Aldridge, Board Treasurer for evaluating many banking options during this process and putting these changes in place.

We currently have 5 Board of Directors. During the June Board meeting it was decided that we would move ahead with 5 instead of 7 as we have done in the past. To do this we will not be filling the VP2 position which was dedicated to a social director. We also did not receive any interest in the Secretary position this year. We have placed the roles Treasurer and Secretary under Jennifer Aldridge's ownership. Since April of 2025, the board's social leadership was incorporated into the VP1 position. Our membership asked for and was granted the leadership. This change established that members would be designated the Chairperson by volunteering and they would lead our HOA events. This structure has proven to be successful. Joseph Reiss will remain our VP1 as he has been for the past two and a half years. Renald Fluet will be responsible for both Resident and Facility issues going forward.

Your Board is committed to working for you our members and these adjustments will assist us in going forward!

- Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

## First Aid

- First Aid Manual
- Sterile adhesive bandages of different sizes
- Sterile gauze pads
- Scissors
- Tweezers
- Moistened towelettes
- Antiseptic
- Disinfectant wipes
- Hand sanitizer
- Aspirin or other pain reliever

## Important Documents

- Insurance cards
  - Medical records
  - Banking information
  - Copies of social security cards
  - Copies of birth and/or marriage certificates
- \*Items should be kept in a water proof container*

## Special Needs Items

- Specialty items for infants, small children, the elderly, and family members with disabilities

## Pet Care Items

- Pet food and water to last at least 7 days
- Proper identification
- Medical records/ microchip information
- Water and food bowls

## Clothing

- Rain gear such as jackets, hats, umbrellas and rain boots
- Sturdy shoes or boots and work gloves

## Food and Water

- Food

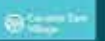

## July's Topic:

## Mobility & Injury Prevention

### DID YOU KNOW?

Your body relies on three inputs to stay steady – your inner ear, your vision, and signals from your feet and joints. When any one shifts with age, your body works harder to compensate. Common medications – including blood pressure, sleep aids, and allergy medication – can also affect balance and reaction time in ways that can feel like "just getting older."

### TOP 3 PREVENTABLE INJURIES

- **Hip Fractures:** Falls cause 95% of all hip fractures. Building daily habits that prevent falls can directly prevent fractures.
- **Knee Breakdown:** Muscle weakness quietly affects your gait and balance, increasing your fall risk significantly over time.
- **Soft tissue injuries** – like rotator cuff tears – affect 30% of adults over 60, and most happen from everyday movements like reaching, swinging, or catching a fall.

### DAILY MOBILITY ROUTINE

#### Morning:

- Seated ankle circles
- Gentle neck rolls
- Seated figure-four hip stretch

#### Before Activity:

- Thoracic spine rotation
- Standing calf raises
- Shoulder cross-body stretch

#### Anytime:

- Slow sit-to-stand from a chair
- Short walk after meals



### FALL PREVENTION CHECKLIST

- Stretch before activity; strengthening hip, ankle, and core muscles
- Review medications that may affect balance with your doctor
- Reduce home hazards like loose rugs and poor lighting
