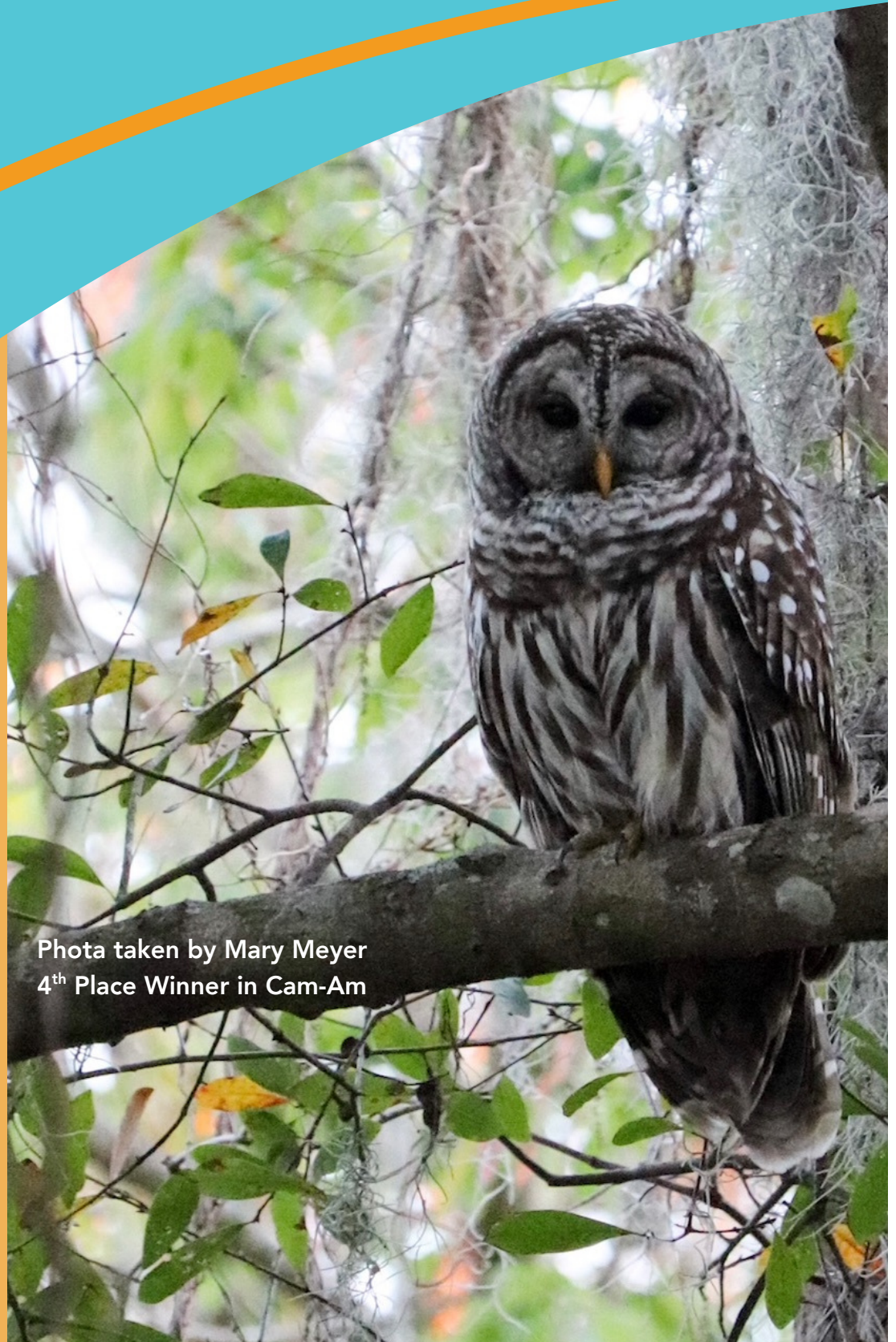

Aqua chi uses chi gong sets and movements from tai chi forms to work the entire body without stress.

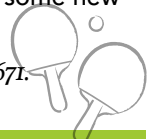

HELPFUL TIPS FOR SUMMER GOLF

Summer is arguably the best season for golf, with an abundance of sunshine and daylight hours. It's also hot on and off the golf course. Perhaps very hot. Following is a handful of tips for dealing with the heat and enjoying golf to the fullest in the good old summertime.

Drink lots of water to stay hydrated-It's essential to drink plenty of water in hot weather. Remember, water is the best fluid for your body, hands down. Playing in the summer heat will suck the moisture right out of you, bring plenty of water with you and take advantage of the water stations around the course. It will help you to stay hydrated and keep your body cool. Another smart tip: Start drinking water before you arrive at the golf course.

Wear sunscreen-Protect your skin from harmful UV rays by slathering on sunscreen. For sunny, hot, and humid days, the American Academy of Dermatology recommends a sunscreen with an SPF (sun protection factor) of at least 30. Reapply sunscreen at the turn or every hour or two. Protective lip balm is also a good idea. Don't forget your sunglasses, your eyes can get a sunburn too!

Carry a towel-Sweat happens. Keep a towel handy to wipe the perspiration from your hands and grips so the clubs don't slip mid swing. You can also wet the towel and use it to keep your neck and head cool in extreme heat.

Be aware of how you feel-Heat stroke is dangerous. Know the signs of dehydration and heat exhaustion: weakness, headache, muscle cramps, irritability, nausea, vomiting, light-headedness, feeling hot on head and neck, dry and sticky mouth, tiredness, lack of sweating and rapid heartbeat. Have a cell phone handy in case of an emergency.

Avoid Lightning-Find shelter or simply get off the golf course when lightning is in the area. Golf carts and trees are not safe spots during thunderstorms.

Be social-Play lots of summer golf with your friends. And make new ones.

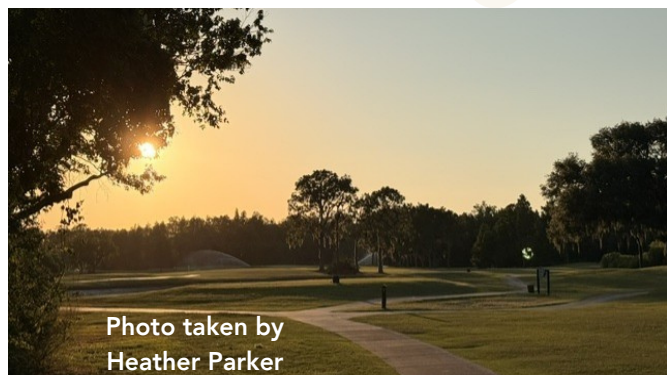

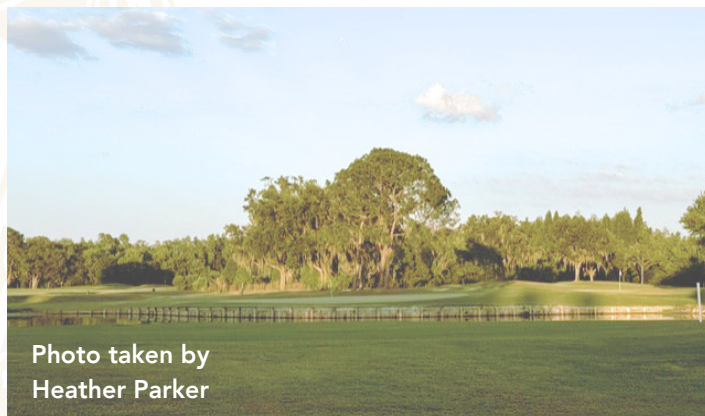

“BETWEEN THE LANES”

As the hot weather season arrives and we enter the “dog days of summer,” we want to ask: “Are you knowledgeable about pedestrian and bicycle safety?” Residents and visitors in our community enjoy taking walks and riding bicycles. Courtesy Patrol is committed to raising awareness with some reminders about potential risks for pedestrians, bicyclists, and drivers, while providing useful safety tips for everyone. Remember to practice the Golden Rule...“treat others as you wish to be treated.”

You Could Be the Pedestrian!

Everyone has their own preferred way to get around, but walking is a part of daily life for all. When both walkers and drivers adhere to safety guidelines, it helps create a safer environment for you and everyone in the community.

Safety Tips for Walkers:

Walk facing traffic and avoid stepping into the path of approaching vehicles. Use crosswalks or intersections to cross streets and stay alert for vehicles coming from all directions, including those making turns. Drivers passing through the Clubhouse and Big Cypress Grill are required to yield to pedestrians using crosswalks. Avoid passing vehicles stopped at these crosswalks, as there may be people crossing whom you cannot see. Walkers, choose a well-lit area with good visibility for an evening stroll. After dark, wear high-visibility and reflective clothing and carry a flashlight while walking your pet for added safety.

Bicycle Safety Guidelines:

Ensure your bicycle is in good working condition by regularly checking all equipment, including brakes, gears, and tires. Stay visible by wearing a helmet, appropriate shoes, and bright or reflective clothing at night, and always use a bike light. Cyclists must follow traffic rules and signs, including stopping at stop signs and yielding as required. Ride with traffic, stay to the right, and avoid cutting in front of oncoming vehicles...they have the right of way!

Motorist & Golf Cart Safety Tips:

Please follow all road regulations to set a positive example for visitors, contractors, and delivery drivers. Be courteous! Observe stop signs and the speed limits. Avoid cutting off vehicles in the visitor lane at the Gatehouse, especially those receiving a pass possibly to go to your home. Take extra care when backing out of your driveway. Do not pass on double yellow lines, especially at bridges or crosswalks, and always yield to pedestrians and wildlife.

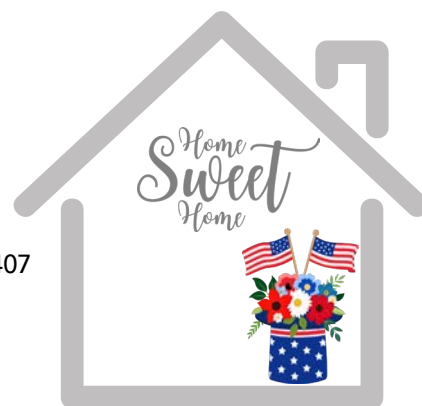

CITIZENS ASSISTED PATROL (CAP)

Alert Polk – Keeping Citizen's Informed In the event of emergency situations, weather events or critical community alerts, county officials will call you! Fill out this card, available in the Oak Room, and stay in touch with important information emailed, texted or called to your cell phone or land line! There is a second card to fill out for our community only information. This card is also in the Oak Room and can be returned to the HOA Office.

Though our seasonal residents are gone, there's still plenty of traffic and the need for you to exercise caution and good judgment while driving. Don't pass on curves or when it's specifically marked. Please proceed slowly when passing parked vehicles at the clubhouse, as well as, abiding by the 15 mph speed limit signs. Remember that stop signs apply to cars and golf carts. Bicyclists should always be aware of their surroundings. Walkers should walk single file in the roadways and wear reflective clothes.

The regular monthly Cypress Lakes CAP meeting will be Tuesday, July 8 at 10 am in the Oak Room. House Checks continue through the summer months and several teams are prepared to do perimeter checks once weekly. We will be reviewing our first aid and safety supplies and have prepared our short list of roster members who will be on site during the summer months. Though CAP is only activated through the CERT program, we are instrumental in support of their efforts for community safety in case of storm emergencies. Make sure YOU are prepared, as well! Cypress Lakes will be hosting the monthly CAP Coordinators meeting on the 27th. You, too, can be part of this important volunteer group! KNOW THE SEVERE WEATHER TERMS

Tropical Storm Watch-A Watch is issued by the National Weather Service when winds from 39 to 73 miles per hour, could be hitting a specified area within 48 hours.

Tropical Storm Warning-A Warning is issued by the National Weather Service when winds are between 48 knots (89km/h, 55 mph) and 63 knots (117 km/h, 73 mph) are occurring or predicted to occur soon.

CERT

July has arrived here at Cypress Lakes Village, and with it comes the peak of Florida's summer heat. While we're all used to warm weather, the combination of high temperatures and humidity this time of year can create dangerous conditions quickly — especially for older adults. A few simple precautions can help keep everyone safe during these hotter months.

First, stay hydrated. Even if you don't feel thirsty, your body needs more water than usual in extreme heat. Keep a bottle with you throughout the day, and avoid excessive alcohol or caffeine, which can contribute to dehydration. If you're spending time outdoors, take frequent breaks in the shade or indoors.

Second, be mindful of heat-related illnesses. Symptoms such as dizziness, headache, nausea, confusion, or excessive sweating can be early warning signs of heat exhaustion. If these symptoms appear, move to a cool place immediately, sip water, and rest. Heat stroke is a medical emergency — call 911 right away if someone stops sweating, becomes disoriented, or loses consciousness.

Finally, please remember to look out for your neighbors. A quick check-in can make all the difference, especially for residents who live alone or have medical conditions. If you notice newspapers piling up, shades closed for days, or a neighbor who isn't answering the door, trust your instincts and reach out.

Your Cypress Lakes Village CERT team is here to support the community, but we need more volunteers to stay strong. No experience is needed — just a willingness to help. Our next meeting is Wednesday, July 29, 2026 at 7:00pm in the Oak Room. We would love to see some new faces.

If a water quality advisory is issued for your community, it will be posted on the above website's [Alerts](#) page. It will also be posted on the [My Utility Account](#) customer portal. You have to be registered on My Utility Account to receive these alerts through your phone's mobile app, phone notifications, or by email.

Boil Water Advisories-Boil Water Advisories are issued when a community's drinking water has the potential or is known to have bacteria, viruses or parasites that can cause illness; and boiling will effectively remove/kill these contaminants.

Precautions During a Boil Water Advisory-During a Boil Water Advisory, tap water used for the following purposes should be brought to a rolling boil for at least two (2) minutes prior to use.

- Drinking and ice cubes
- Liquids or food (e.g., tea or soup) that will not be boiled for at least two (2) minutes
- Washing fruits and vegetables being eaten raw
- Brushing teeth or cleaning dental and medical appliances
- Preparing baby food and infant formula
- Bathing infants
- Pets

Adults, adolescents, and older children may shower, bathe, or wash using tap water, but should avoid swallowing it. It's recommended to sponge bathe infants if using tap water. Tap water may be used for dishes washed by machine but add bleach to water used for dishes washed by hand. Water used for other household purposes does not need to be boiled.

Lifting a Boil Water Advisory-A Boil Water Advisory can only be lifted (rescinded) once laboratory testing has determined water is safe to drink. Once this has been confirmed, we advise local health authorities and issue public notices. You can check if a recent advisory has been lifted on our [Alerts](#) page or the [My Utility Account](#) customer portal.

Once a Boil Water Advisory has been lifted, you should follow these simple steps to ensure all old water in plumbing and appliances is replaced with new.

- Flush all faucets, fountains, and garden hoses for at least 5 minutes: longer if water continues cloudy or discolored.
- Discard any drinks, ice, food, etc., made during the Advisory.
- Rewash any food or drink contact items (knives, forks, plates, etc.).
- Check water filters (in faucets, refrigerators and elsewhere) and replace if necessary.
- Run water softeners through a regeneration cycle.
- Do not use water from your hot water heater for drinking until several exchanges of the tank have occurred.
- Run the dishwasher through one or two cycles before washing dishes

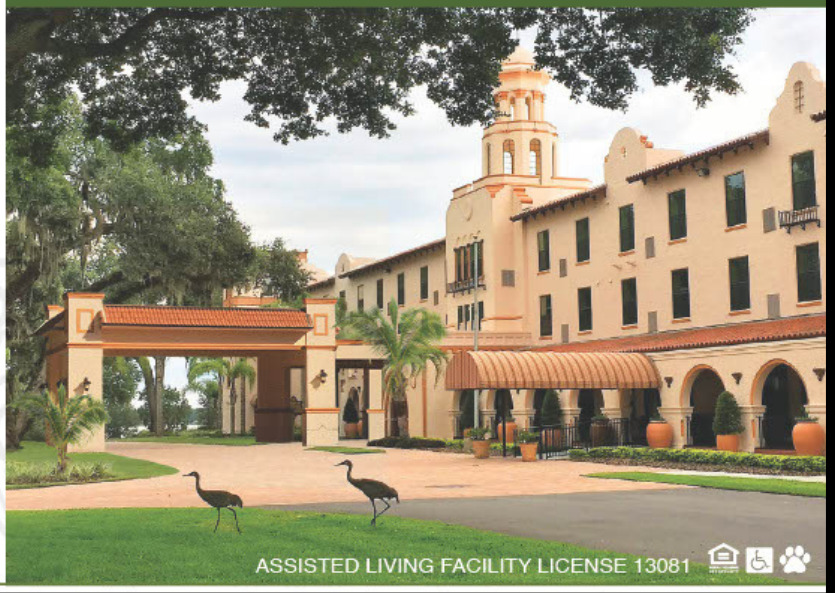

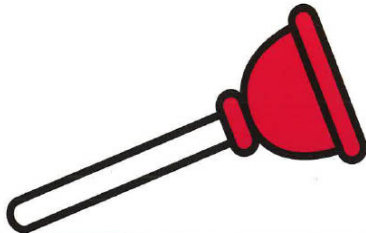

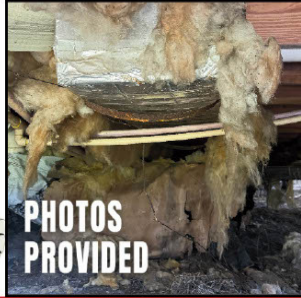
