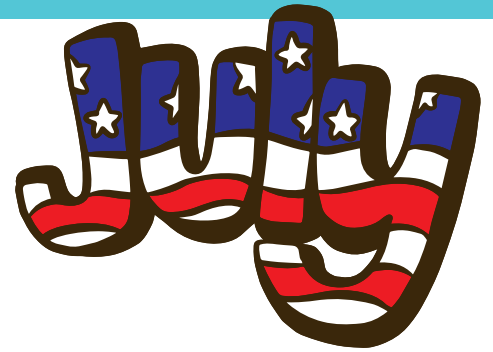



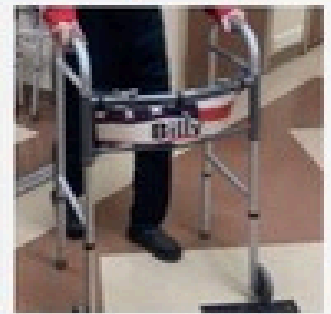

I LIVE TO EAT

Ever since I found out that Americans can buy houses in a small town in Sardinia for \$10 (yes, that's right, not a typo), the girls and I have been dreaming about buying a compound and hiring a "houseboy" named Guido who provides a variety of services. Since I don't think it's going to happen any time soon, we decided to do the next best thing and go to the "Sardinia Restaurant". I'm so glad we did because it was a fabulous experience. We had our own private dining room with a fantastic server named Ariadna and the food was awesome. I went for the full on meal from wine to dessert. I had a glass of Sardinian red wine, very smooth and balanced. Then came cioppino, full of fish. My entree was linguine with clams and bottarga. If you are unfamiliar with bottarga, it is a type of caviar that is compressed and then flaked over the food. Just enough to give you that brinness you associate with caviar. All the other diners were pleased with their dishes although, a couple of them said the portions were a little light. To finish, I had a caramel panna cotta, so creamy and dreamy. All of the food, including the pasta, is homemade. We even had a visit from the owner/chef Dino twice. While there are some Italian classics like lasagna on the menu, I recommend trying one of the Sardinian dishes. It's Italian food with a little twist. We were still talking about the fun we had several days later. The prices are moderate but what isn't these days?! There is some outside seating. Even if you don't sit in the private room, there is still a lovely dining area with friendly service and great food. Maybe you'll see Guido and me there if you go.

FORTH OF JULY FACTS



- **THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE WAS ADOPTED ON JULY 4, 1776, BY THE CONTINENTAL CONGRESS: THIS MARKED THE FORMAL DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE FROM GREAT BRITAIN.**
- **THE FIRST OFFICIAL FORTH OF JULY CELEBRATION TOOK PLACE IN PHILADELPHIA IN 1777: THIS INCLUDED A PARADE FIREWORKS, AND CANNON SALUTES.**
- **CONGRESS MADE INDEPENDENCE DAY AN UNPAID FEDERAL HOLIDAY IN 1870 AND A PAID FEDERAL HOLIDAY IN 1938.**
- **THE LIBERTY BELL IN PHILADELPHIA IS TAPPED 13 TIMES EVERY FORTH OF JULY: THIS HONORS THE ORIGINAL 13 COLONIES.**
- **THREE U.S. PRESIDENTS DIED ON JULY 4: JOHN ADAMS, THOMAS JEFFERSON, AND JAMES MONROE.**

TRADITIONS AND CELEBRATIONS:

- **FIREWORKS ARE A MAJOR PART OF FOURTH OF JULY CELEBRATIONS: THEY HAVE BEEN PART OF THE TRADITION SINCE THE VERY FIRST CELEBRATIONS.**
- **AMERICANS CONSUME A LARGE NUMBER OF HOT DOGS ON THE FORTH OF JULY: IT'S THE BIGGEST HOT DOG HOLIDAY OF THE YEAR.**

OTHER INTERESTING FACTS:

- **THE AVERAGE AGE OF THE SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE WAS 45.**
- **SOME OF THE SIGNERS WERE EDUCATED AT HARVARD.**
- **THE FIRST STATE TO RECOGNIZE JULY 4TH AS A HOLIDAY WAS MASSACHUSETTS IN 1781.**
- **THERE WERE AN ESTIMATED 2.5 MILLION PEOPLE LIVING IN THE 13 COLONIES ON JULY 4, 1776.**
- **THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE WAS WRITTEN LARGELY BY JEFFERSON. THE VOTE FOR THE ACTUAL INDEPENDENCE TOOK PLACE ON JULY 2ND, FROM THEN ON THE 4TH BECAME THE DAY THAT WAS CELEBRATED AS THE BIRTH OF AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE.**
