Why we can't Wear White after Labor Day
 is highly debatable

Three hypotheses explain the origins of the "no white after Labor Day" directive. The first theory, disputed by many, is based on class distinctions in the early 1900s. Although white clothing was clearly an upper-class luxury, after the Civil War it became harder to distinguish women with old money from those with new money. Higher-class ladies then made up fashion rules to weed out those who were "out of place."

The second theory takes a more practical approach, pointing out that Memorial Day and Labor Day bracketed the summer season, so lighter, summery, white clothes were no longer needed.

The last theory has to do with popular fashion magazines, which may have begun promoting fall clothing after Labor Day, and the trend was picked up.

Labor Day is a U.S. federal holiday celebrated on the first Monday of September to **honor American workers**, **recognize the labor movement**, and **mark the unofficial end of summer**.

History and Origins

- **Industrial Roots:** Created in the late 19th century during the Industrial Revolution, when harsh conditions, 12-hour workdays, and unsafe factories led workers to organize.
- **First March:** On September 5, 1882, 10,000 workers held a parade in New York City to support a shorter workday and better pay.
- **Federal Law:** President Grover Cleveland signed it into law on June 28, 1894, after a major railway strike pushed worker rights into national focus.

The first unofficial Labor Day occurred in New York City on September 5, 1882. On this day, thousands of union members marched to Union Square, petitioning for shorter workdays and better working conditions. While this looming victory for workers across the country was worth celebrating, the holiday's origins go back much farther.

Decades prior, in the 1830s, employees in most manufacturing industries were working seven days a week, laboring under a monstrous **70-hour workweek**. These unsustainable working conditions were exactly what union organizers focused on when trying to establish a shorter workweek and workday. They also attempted to help workers get more days, like Labor Day, off.

Although employees succeeded in establishing a Labor Day parade in 1882, it didn't immediately become a public holiday. It took over a decade for half of the states in the U.S. to recognize and honor the day as a holiday. Even then, it wasn't until President Grover Cleveland signed the Labor Day bill in 1894 that it became a national holiday.

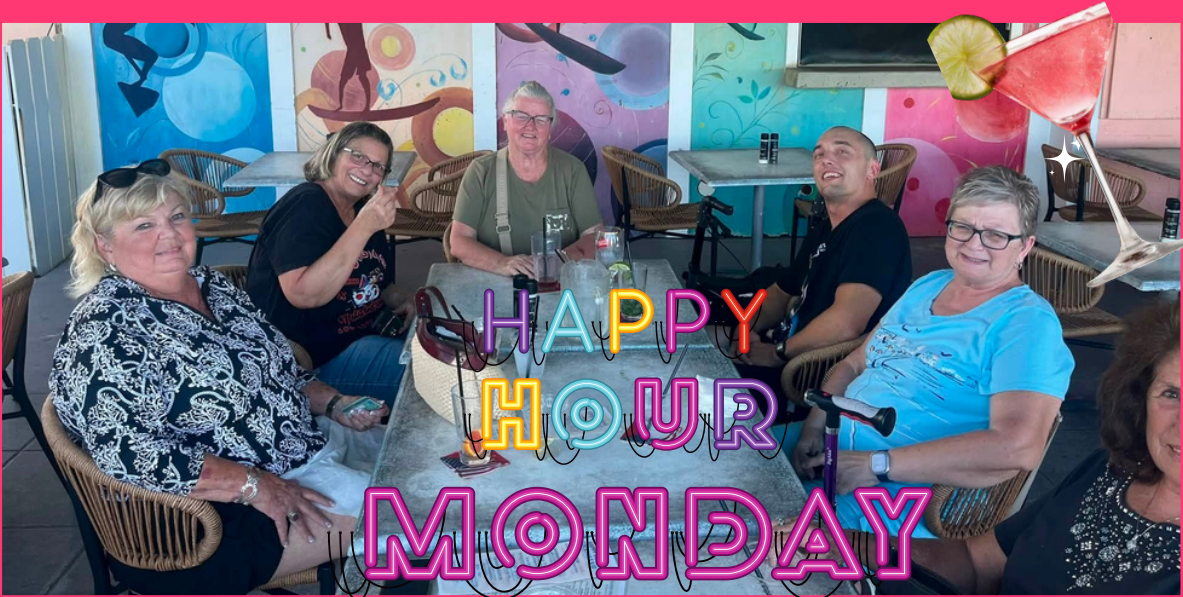
