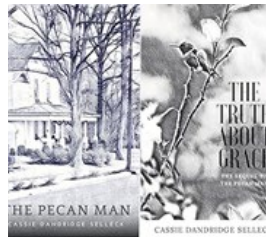

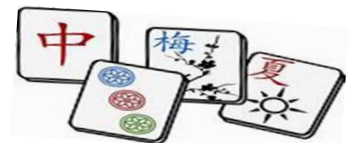

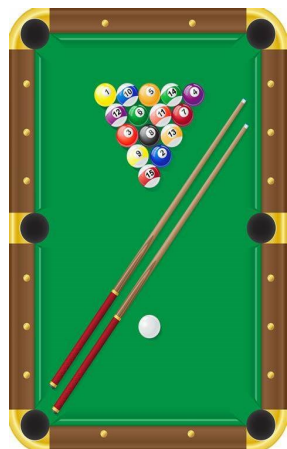
FAST TRACK by Beth Sullivan
