Hello Residents of Strawberry Ridge,

Summer is officially here, and we are starting to get some rain. Please remember to keep your yards and trees maintained. Also remember that there are water restrictions in place set by Hillsborough County. There are designated days and times that you can water your lawn. You can find this information at:

A few other issues that continue to arise that I need to mention.

- Please make sure that your trash and yard waste is curbside by 8 am. Your yard waste needs to be bundled and/or bagged in order for it to be removed.
- We continue to have issues with parking. Please do not park in the grass and overnight parking is not allowed on the streets. If someone is day parked on the street, please do not park on the opposite side of the street as it makes it hard to get around between two cars parked across from each other.
- Please stop at all stop sign and maintain the speed limits.
- After hours and weekend **Access** to the maintenance yard and RV storage lot is restricted to those who pay for storage. If you are provided with the new lock code, please do not give it out to anyone else.
- Noise disturbances have been brought to my attention as well. Remember that between 10:00 pm 8:00am there should not be loud noises that disturb your neighbors.

What is C.E.R.T.? It is **C**ommunity **E**mergency **R**esponse **T**eam. Are you a member of the Strawberry Ridge Village CERT Team? If not, why aren't you. Just what does this team do for our residents. Well, in the event of a power failure, the CERT Team will make sure those people affected will have a meal which is prepared by our team. If tree limbs come down, we try to get them out of way so cars can get through. There are many other things we do which is too much to list. Why not come to our meeting and ask and learn more about us. We meet 1 evening each month always the second Thursday of the month at 6:30 pm in the Activity Center. Our next meeting will be on July 11th.

LENDING CLOSET

Before you purchase any necessary Durable Medical Equipment:

Check with the Strawberry Ridge Village Lending Closet, located at the Clubhouse, which provides medical equipment to our residents upon request. Call us and one of our volunteers will be happy to assist you by providing many of your needs on an available basis. This service is at no cost to our residents, is a great cost-saving measure, and the loan of the equipment has no time limit. You may keep the equipment if it is necessary.

We have wheelchairs, transfer chairs, crutches, canes, walkers, bed rails, potty chairs, and shower chairs. These items are available for all our residents to borrow. Donations of the mentioned items are also accepted. There are limits on the type of supplies we can accept. We cannot accept respiratory items, diapers, walking boots, medications, stability belts or other disposable items. All that we ask is that when returning borrowed items or donating items please ensure that all items have been cleaned and are fully operational. The volunteer staff does not have the ability to clean or repair any items. Presently, the Lending Closet is in short supply of Rollator Walkers. Any donation of or return of one no longer needed would be appreciated.

Too Many Pink Flags Make One Large Red Flag

I swear I was just trying to do a simple task...cancel a charge against my checking account for a service I no longer needed.

Seemed simple. I called the listed number and was assured that this task could easily be accomplished by my completing a simple form so that it would be documented. The document immediately appeared on my screen. I dutifully completed all the questions with birth dates for myself and my husband, addresses, email addresses and may even had completed the request for social security numbers. #1 pink flag.

Then the "nice" gentleman filled out the amount due me but happened to make a little error by \$3200 overage. Since this was being deposited to my checking account, I now had the obligation to go to the bank, withdraw the excess funds in cash and return it to the company. #2 pink flag.

I checked my computer and "saw" the deposit on the deposit page so I could easily see the "overage" error.

So I headed to the bank with my husband driving. I was requested not to talk while en route as all was being tape recorded and there should be no interference. So I said nothing to my husband to explain this "strange" transaction. #3 pink flag.

After withdrawing the requisite "overage", we headed to a machine where I could deposit the funds to the corporation. Turned out to be a Bit coin machine in Plant City in a little one horse store. The pink flags are rapidly mounting. But I dutifully deposited the funds, requested a receipt but none was forthcoming. A male stranger in the store was helping me and he inquired whether this was a scam. I assured him that it was legitimate because I had seen the deposit in my checking account. WRONG!

I returned to the car, pulled up my checking account on my phone and saw that the deposit was never made; it was just a scam. And I had cooperated completely. In addition my computer and phone were hacked. I had lost all our money, had to have phone and computer cleaned, and had to borrow a zillion dollars.

So, big lessons learned.

- Scammers are accomplished artists who know the ins and outs of posting a false document on a bank account.
- They are great performers in being persuasive to take a person down the wrong path.
- They are people who have no conscience or remorse for stealing from Jane or John Doe.
- The government has little resources to apprehend these persons.

If something doesn't feel right, it probably isn't. Hang up the phone. When I called the number back, I received a message that the dialed number was a "scam"!

Take precautions early on with any request for exchange of money. Don't be a "scam-me!"


