We started a Breakfast Potluck with good attendance and will transition to this each month on the second Saturday at 8:30 am. Please come join us!

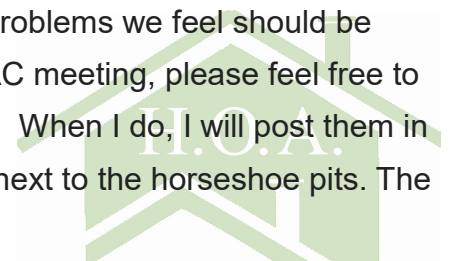

We have quarterly RAC (Resident Advisory Committee) meetings with Todd Green (our Manager), Cindy King (Regional Manager) and five (5) residents from the park. This is our opportunity to get some answers on what we would like to have changed and/or what problems we feel should be looked into. When I do, I will post them in the HOA display case in the clubhouse, and also in the display case next to the horseshoe pits. The minutes of our previous meeting are in these display cases.

4. We are still in the planning and permitting phase of the docks. This is a long process because we have to go through so many governmental agencies.

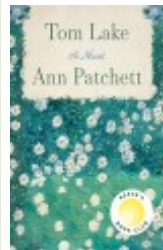

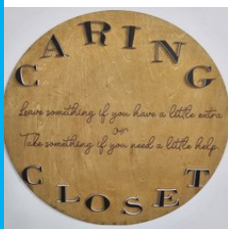
Our **July book club meeting** will be at **2:00 pm on Monday, July 8th**. The book for our July meeting will be

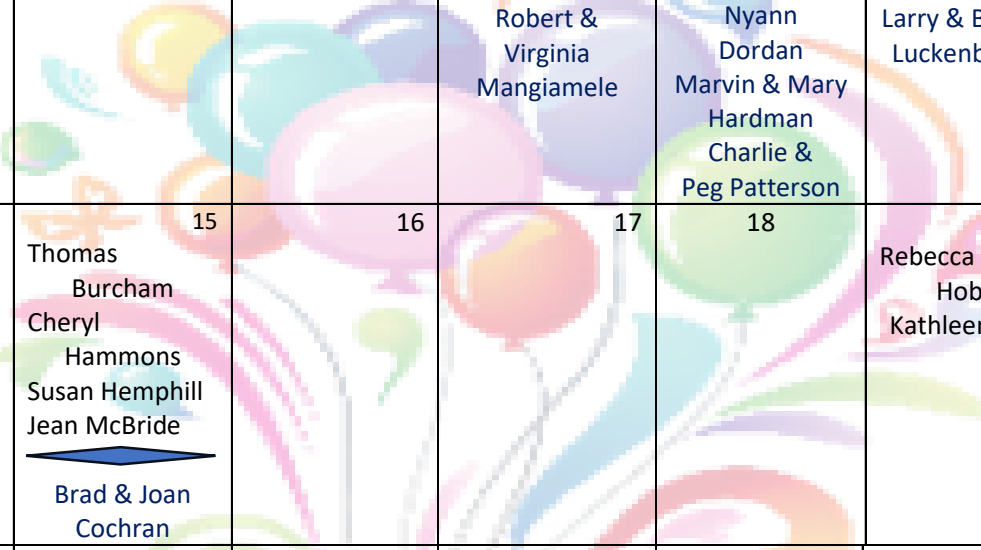
LINE DANCING by Joyce Woodington

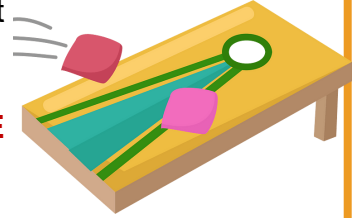

FAST TRACK by Beth Sullivan

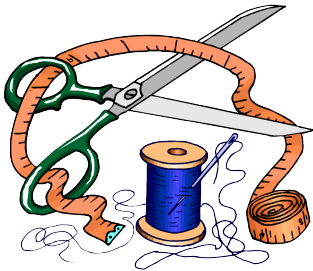
We play every **2nd & 4th Tuesday, 12:30-2:30 pm**. Fast Track is a board game and is similar to Sorry/Aggravation.
